



2024 Dodgen MS Eighth Grade Orchestra GMEA Large Group Performance Evaluation

Dear Orchestra Parents and Students,

Each year the Dodgen Orchestras are required to participate in only one competitive/adjudicated performance. This event is sponsored by the Georgia Music Educators Association (GMEA) and is called Large Group Performance Evaluation (LGPE). At this event, the orchestra and directors will be evaluated on our appearance, stage behavior, music selection, all aspects of our performance skills, and sight-reading ability. We will earn numeric ratings and comments by three GMEA-certified Orchestra judges and one sight-reading judge (overall group rating, not individual). This event is a valuable learning opportunity that is equivalent to the Milestones testing and provides motivation for students to do their best on the chosen music. Each individual student's performance skills and behavior are crucial to the success of this large group performance.

The goals of Orchestra Large Group Performance Evaluation participation are:

- To raise the standards of musicianship, instrumentation, technical knowledge, and literature selection of performers
- To promote the development of musical knowledge as expressed in performance through evaluation, advice and suggestion
- To offer students, parents, and teachers the opportunity to listen to the best work of peer groups from other schools

GMEA District 12 LGPE will be held on **February 8th** and we will walk to Walton High School. After the event parents should pick up from Walton. Here is the general schedule for the day:

Night Before	Get uniform together, practice
Before School	Drop off uniform and instrument in OR, go through school day as normal, rehearse on stage
4:15 pm	At dismissal, all students report to theater for Chick-Fil-A meal (or bring food from home)
4:40 pm	Change into uniform and gather instrument, equipment, music, uniform for the walk to Walton
5:15 pm	Depart for Walton HS- WALKING- wear a coat, hat, gloves, scarf, etc- bring umbrella if rain is forecasted, students may wear comfortable walking shoes and change into dress shoes at Walton
5:30 pm	Unpack and go to stage for tuning and warmup
6:30 pm	STAGE PERFORMANCE- Walton High School Auditorium (open to parents)
7:00 pm	Students move to another classroom for sight reading evaluation
7:25 pm	Students pack up and depart Walton with parents
7:30 pm	Parent pick up FROM WALTON in front of the auditorium at 7:30 pm

We need 10-12 parent chaperones to assist with this trip. We need help with the meal and walking students safely across to Walton HS. We will have to quickly move a lot of equipment from place to place without leaving anything behind. Student behavior will also need to be supervised during this event.
