In addition to Public Service Announcements aired in support of National, Regional and Local Organizations and Programs, our programming contains special programs devoted to our community's businesses and organizations. The following lists and describes these special programs.

LOCAL NEWS: Aired twice a day at 7:00 AM and 12:00 PM. New items included relate to local events of interest in this community.

GOLF REPORT: Aired at 7:31 AM. This gives the local golf course's tee times, course conditions, latest noteworthy activities and upcoming special events.

COMMUNITY CALENDAR: This lists local church and organization activities. The need is so great for this type of programming that it airs four times a day seven days a week.

TAKE FIVE: This special program was created solely to allow a more in-depth interview with key personnel in local business and organizations, thereby allowing the community to have a greater awareness of organizations and new businesses in their area. It features a 5 minute interview daily or sometimes a 15 or 20 minute interview is divided into several segments and aired on successive days. The need for more than one program a day is often the case.

ASK YOUR NEIGHBOR: An hour open to calls on local and toll-free phone lines. Only politics and medical problems are not allowed as topics. The main purpose of the program is for "neighbors" in the listening area to request information on items they need, recipes they would like to have, help with lawn or household problems, recommendations of local workers; and then for other "neighbors" to call in with solutions or suggestions for the problems. Some of these neighbors become true friends without having ever seen one another face-to-face.

LOCAL SCHOOL NEWS: Local high schools are contacted and offered the opportunity to report their activities on a weekly basis.
