1 Plaintiffs Talia Jackson, Nathan Alfano, and Kristen Moore (together, the
2 “Plaintiffs”) and defendants Melissa Bacelar, Wagmor Pets, Wylder’s Holistic Pet
3 Center, Inc. d/b/a The Wagmor (together, the “Defendants”) (collectively, with the
4 Plaintiffs, the “Parties”) through their respective counsel submit this Joint Status
5 Report.

6 **A. PLAINTIFFS’ POSITION:**

7 On January 24, 2024, the Parties attended a full-day, in-person mediation session
8 before the Hon. Suzanne Segal (Ret.) of Signature Resolution. Following several post-
9 mediation communications through the assistance of Judge Segal, Plaintiffs and
10 Defendants’ insurance carrier, The Hartford, reached a proposed class action settlement
11 in principle on or about February 26, 2024. Plaintiffs anticipate being able to file a
12 Motion for Preliminary Approval no later than May 24, 2024.

13 Plaintiffs request that all other deadlines in the action be stayed pending the
14 anticipated class action settlement.

15 **B. DEFENDANTS’ POSITION:**

16 The mediation apparently resulted in a settlement between Hartford (defendants’
17 insurer) and the Plaintiffs. Defendants are not parties to the settlement, and reserve all
18 of their rights.
