

Creeks Edge Social Committee Charter

Purpose

The Social Committee exists to encourage community and connection in the families of the Creeks Edge Neighborhood. Committee includes Chairman, Admin Secretary and members. Budget determined annually.

Responsibilities

- Planning, funding, advertising, execution and clean-up of two neighborhood wide events per year: Holiday party in December and Outdoor party early summer
- Liaison between Board and community members with event requests beyond the scope and authority of the Social Committee
- Chairman or designated representative attends and reports at monthly Board meetings
- Clubhouse reservation management
- Welcome Representative to new neighbors
- Installation, break down, storage and maintenance of holiday decorations for the neighborhood and the clubhouse

Membership:

- The Social Committee will be comprised of at least 4 members in addition to the Committee Chair and the Admin Secretary. The Committee Chair will be responsible for recruiting committee members.

Meetings:

- The committee will meet at least quarterly and plan resources and times to implement activities. Meetings will be announced and open to all residents. Minutes will be recorded by the Admin Secretary.
