6TH GRADE BOOTCAMP

Northwood Middle School will host their 6th grade class at "Boot Camp" on Monday, August 5th starting @ 2:30 pm! This is our back-to-school event that will help our 6th graders get prepared for the beginning of the school year.

Students will need to be dropped off by 2:30 pm. They will be given the opportunity to practice opening a locker and learn how to have a successful 6th grade year. At the end of Boot Camp, students will be given their class schedules and an opportunity to meet their teachers.



A Parent Boot Camp will be offered from 4:15-5:15 pm. This will give parents an opportunity to learn about middle school and ways to ensure that your child has a great transition to 6th grade. This parent session is optional.

Parents will then meet up with their students at 5:15pm. Students and parents will have the opportunity to meet teachers, listen to teacher presentations, and walk the student's schedule. This part of the event will last from 5:30-6:45 pm.

DRESS CODE TO THE SCHOOL

At Northwood, we pride ourselves in being an exceptional school! The personal appearance of every student is an important component of establishing a safe environment for optimal learning and respect for one another. The information provided below highlights some of the components of our dress code. Please review the full dress code policy in the Northwood student agenda/handbook.

Shirts:

- Tops must be solid white, navy, or black.
- Tops must have collars, buttons, and sleeves.
- Tops may have a small, appropriate logo over the pocket area only.

Pants, shorts, skirts:

- Bottoms must be solid khaki, navy, or black.
- Jeans and bottoms made to look like jeans are not permitted.
- Shorts and skirts must measure fingertip length when standing upright in a relaxed position.

Miscellaneous:

- All clothing must be free from holes, faux holes, patched holes, rips, etc.
- Appropriate shoes, sneakers, or sandals must be worn. Flip-flops, bedroom shoes, slides, or shower-type shoes are not permitted.
- Shoes and socks must not be distracting.
- Lightweight, non-hooded sweatshirts, sweaters, and jackets may be worn in the classroom, provided they are solid colored white, navy, or black and have a regulation shirt underneath them.

Students who come to school inappropriately dressed will be asked to call home to have an appropriate item brought to them. Students will then be instructed to wait in the in-school suspension room until a parent arrives.



ADDRESS & PHONE NUMBER CHANGE

It is very important that the school has up-to-date contact information for each student. The school district requires two proofs of address (current utility bill or contract on a house or apartment) for an address change. To have your phone number changed in the computer, please call the main office (864-355-7000) or send it in written form with your student's name on it. You can also update phone numbers on Parent Backpack.



TDAP VACCINE - 7TH GRADERS

South Carolina law requires that students entering the 7th grade receive a dose of Tdap vaccine. Students entering the 7th grade who have not received the vaccine will not be allowed to receive their class schedule or attend school until they have received the vaccine and provided proof to the school nurse. If you are unsure if your child has met this requirement, please contact our school nurse, Ms. Forrester at (864) 355-7007.

Northwood Designated as "School to Watch"

In February 2022, Northwood was designated as a School to Watch by the National Forum to Accelerate Middle Grades Reform. Our emphasis on strong academics, sensitivity to young adolescents' needs and interests, and commitment to providing all students equal access to a high-quality education resulted in this well-deserved recognition.

U.S. News & World Report Top 50 Ranking

Last October, U.S. News & World Report announced their 2022 "Best K-8 Schools" rankings. For the first time, U.S. News published rankings and data on more than 80,000 public elementary and middle schools across the country. Schools were ranked at the state and district levels. Out of 345 middle schools in the state, GCS had five schools in the Top 50 ... and Northwood Middle School holds the #41 SPOT IN THE STATE!

STUDENT DROP OFF AND PICK UP



No student may be dropped off at school before 7:30 AM, and all students need to be picked up by 4:00 PM after school.

For safety reasons, students should be dropped off and picked up at the front of the school. Do not pull into the parking lot to drop off or pick up students.
