

## WORSHIP TEAM OVERVIEW

The Worship Team at Momentum leads the church spiritually and physically with our posture, and musically into a deeper understanding and worship of our God to help the mission of our church become a reality: to lead people forward into an empowered life in Christ.

## THE WIN

We're not just hitting drums, playing chords, or singing a song but we are creating an environment for God to speak, revitalize, and refresh the people who are coming into our church and modeling what it means to worship and glorify our God in song and in our expression. It is not enough to simply lead worship with music, we must also lead with our body language. Our passionate praise might be the very thing that contributes to someone's prison doors being opened or their walls breaking down. At Momentum, we do not praise passively, we praise passionately. If the Worship Team executes well individually to make the collective worship experience excellent, then we will help to create an immersive experience where people can experience radical transformation with the message of Jesus.

## GUIDELINES

- On the Auditorium Teams (Worship and Production) we use call times. Call times are not times to arrive but times to be at your position ready to go. Because each position has a different set-up and different preparation we use one call time for all Auditorium teams. Call time for Sunday mornings is 7:00 am.
- Your time commitment on a Sunday morning will be approximately 6 hours from call time to completion of Sunday services. We will be launching with 2 services to accommodate the large group we anticipate, and will make a determination after launch whether to adjust.
- Practice will be held one night during the week for approximately 2 hours. You are
  required to be at practice in order to play that coming Sunday. The date and time of
  practice may vary at first as we try to understand the various schedules at play and
  work around venue practice space, but our hope is to reach a consistent night for
  practice shortly after launch.
- When you arrive on Sunday check-in at Team Central. The worship team does not wear name tags.
- Being a part of our weekend gatherings matters! When we say 'yes' to using our gifts to serve God by serving others on the Production Team we are committing to faithfully attending services even when we aren't scheduled to serve.

Our goal on the Worship Team is to make people forget that we are there as they
enter into worship. We ask that you wear clothing that will not create distraction.
Here are some helpful hints of what NOT to wear: T-shirts with prints or noticeable
logos (solid shirts are great), shorts, hats, sandals, open-toed shoes, dresses,
skirts, or kilts (sorry blokes), or Yoga pants. If you are wearing tight pants, wear a
longer top.

## **PRO-TIPS**

- Check in with the Music Director to see if there are any specific instructions for the Sunday you are serving.
- Refrain from eating, drinking, or using your phone while serving and while in the Auditorium.
- The Worship Team uses one app to communicate and schedule the service flow: Planning Center. This is where you will find the songs, service items, and team schedule. If scheduled, confirm within 24 hours.
- For scheduling you'll only use three things: **1. Confirm** as soon as possible to let us know you can serve, **2. Blackout** to let the scheduler know in advance when you can't serve, **3. Decline** for emergencies that happen before a Sunday service.
