Show Rules

Make all checks payable to OPHC. Checks will be deposited promptly. NO POST DATED CHECKS. There will be a \$50 fee assessed for EACH time a check is returned by the bank. Credit cards have 4% convenience fee.

1. An entry in the Oregon Paint Horse Club, Painted N Sterling, is considered an entry under ALL judges.
2. Exhibitor Responsibility: SC-160.E-Exhibitors are responsible for being knowledgeable of and following the current rules, completing entry forms legibly and accurately, reporting to the gate promptly and being considerate of other exhibitors and show management. Additionally, exhibitors, owners and trainers are responsible to be knowledgeable of Rule SC-085 Drugs and Medications, forbidden, permitted & conditionally permitted substances. Conditionally permitted substances require a completed medication report be filed with show office. Inhumane treatment of animals on the grounds will not be tolerated. Rule SC-075. Proper action WILL be taken.
3. The Show Secretary or Office Staff MUST inspect the registration papers (or copies of) on each horse entered (except current year foals). Entries shall be made in the name of the recorded owners Rule SC 160.C. Geldings are not allowed to show with stallion papers Rule SC 160.I.3.
4. Leased Horses – the show secretary or office staff MUST inspect the APHA show lease certificate according to rules AM-020.A.1.F & YP-015.A.2.F.
5. To enter Amateur or Novice Amateur classes, you MUST present a current year APHA Amateur or Novice Amateur card, and own your horse according to Rule AM-015, AM-210, and AM-300.C.
6. Novice Youth MUST present a current Novice Youth Card from APHA in order to enter any Novice Youth Class, Rule YP-210. Additionally, Novice Youth may cross enter into the age appropriate Youth Class. Youth must present an AjPHA membership card in order to enter any youth classes (exception being Leadline and Walk/Trot) Rule YP-005.A.5
7. If showing APHA walk/trot no cross entry into all-breed canter/lope classes.
8. All Exhibitors AND Owners must present a current APHA membership card. Rule SC-160.A. The condition of submitting entries or the first entry into the show ring of a horse or exhibitor shall be deemed as acceptance of the APHA Official Rule Book and the Oregon Paint Horse Club general rules.
9. The final right to settle all questions or disputes arising incidentally to the Oregon Paint Horse Club – Painted N Sterling Fall Classic is reserved to the Show Management. All exhibitors, owners, and trainers, as condition of admission, give unqualified consent to such methods of settlement and agree in advance to be bound thereby.
10. Show management may combine or split classes according to APHA rules SC 185.G, AM 080.B, and YP 075.B.
11. Anyone withdrawing (scratching) from a class after entering shall forfeit their entry fee in accordance with Rule SC-185.A.
12. Exhibitors/Owners competing for Oregon Paint Horse Club – Painted N Sterling Fall Classic, are responsible for entering the correct classes to qualify for all awards. Award qualifying class lists will be available as the show.
13. No refund on stalls.
14. No refund on circuit flat fees.
15. One/Horse/One Rider combination to apply to all Youth & Amateur High Points.
16. Halter is required for High Point eligibility except youth 5-10 walk/trot exhibitors
17. Ties for High Points will be broken using the following: 1) The horse that earns the most firsts; 2) The horse that places the most times; 3) The flip of a coin.
18. High Points Awards will not be given out or available until one (1) hour after the last qualifying class. Awards MUST be picked up by the end of the show or be forfeited unless arrangements are made to deliver awards prior to the show ending.
19. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH.
20. **All bedding must be purchased from show management. No outside bedding allowed per Oregon Horse Center.**

Participation Agreement, Notice Release, and Acknowledgement of Risk: I accept and clearly understand that riding a horse can be hazardous, especially in an equestrian event; that there are inherent and other risks involved in riding a horse; and that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence. I freely accept and assume those risks. I therefore release Oregon Family Equestrian Activities, Inc. (OFEA), Oregon Paint Horse Club (OPHC) its members and show grounds' owners and all of their agents and employees, from any and all liability for damage and injury to myself, my horse, or to any person or property resulting from my riding a horse in this equestrian event, accepting myself the full responsibility for any and all such damage or injury of any kind which may result. I agree to fully indemnify, defend, and hold OFEA, OPHC, show grounds' owners and all of their agents and employees, harmless from any and all claims, actions, liability, or costs including attorney fees and other costs of defense, arising out of or in any way related to my riding a horse in this equestrian event. The limitations on liability provided in ORS 30.691 shall apply to an adult participant in the circumstances listed in subsection (1)(b) of this section if the participant, prior to riding, training, driving, grooming or riding as a passenger upon an equine, knowingly executes a release stating that as a condition of participation, the participant waives the right to bring an action against the equine professional or equine activity sponsor for an injury or death arising out of riding, training, driving, grooming or riding as a passenger upon the equine. A release so executed shall be binding upon the adult participant. I hereby certify that every horse is eligible as entered. I make these entries at my own risk and understand that equine events are potentially dangerous. Show management, owners of the facility, OPHC, and/or OFEA shall not be held responsible for any accident, injury or loss that may occur to any exhibitor, their representatives, or to their horses, equipment, or vehicles. Presentation of this entry with my entry fee shall be deemed acceptance of the above. I understand and agree that this show shall be conducted under the rules of APHA, OPHC, OFEA and that of the Show Management.

- ◆ Day stall - \$60/day
- ◆ Stall - \$115/stall (Thursday – Sunday)
- ◆ Haul-In Fee - \$30/horse/day
- ◆ Baled bedding \$11/bag
- ◆ No Refund on stalls
- ◆ **No outside bedding allowed per Oregon Horse Center**

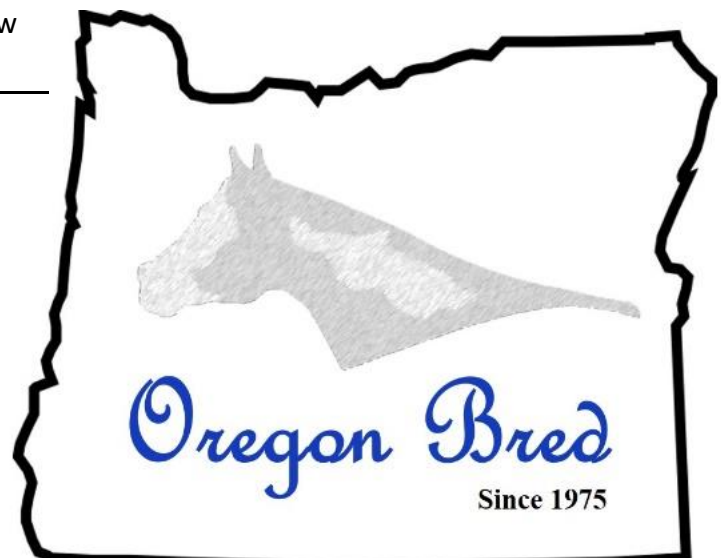

Beginner Class Rules:

- Rider may not have won more than 10 points in any Breed approved competition as of the date of the show weekend in the class entered. Once an exhibitor wins a buckle in a beginning class, are no longer eligible for that class.
- A belt buckle will be awarded to the winner in all Beginning classes.
- Year-End Awards will not be offered for any of the Beginning classes.
- Chaps are not required to show in any Beginning classes. Appropriate attire is required for the class being entered.
- Horses need not to be a registered Paint Horse to show in the Beginning class. Exhibitor does not need to own the horse. Rider/exhibitor may cross-enter into other APHA classes at the show, but must meet all ownership and membership requirements for APHA.
- Beginning Halter is open to mares or geldings of any age to compete in the class.
- Beginner classes are open to youth and amateurs.
- If it is determined that an exhibitor is ineligible for a beginning class, they will be disqualified and any awards will be forfeited.
