Minutes:

Minutes from July were read. Kristen moved and Dakota seconded to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

Treasury Report:

Molly checked on fees from APHA that had gone to Lisa S. They did not receive the first payment so a second check was sent and we have a credit with APHA. We had some memberships come in along with the sweatshirt/t-shirt order money. The invoice for the storage unit came in and is \$600. Molly is going to look into a Paypal account for charging fees for membership and show.

Zone One Report:

There isn't a zone meeting until August 29th. There will be an award discussion so they can regroup for next year.

Youth Report:

No new news. We are going to look into getting a youth member meeting so we can get more youth involved. We need an adult to oversee this. This topic was tabled until the September meeting.

2024 OPHC Show:

Photographer will be Lawran Whitney. We are hoping to hire husband/wife judge pairs to limit the cost of motel rooms. Host hotels will be Holiday Inn on Market Street, The Double Tree and Best Western Premier in Keizer. Delany will get contracts for all three motels. The Holiday Inn doesn't take contracts until 6 months before the event. Cost of Double tree is \$129 for a king and \$139 for two queens. The Best Western in Keizer is 3.7 miles from the fairgrounds and takes about 11 minutes to get there. The Holiday Inn has an on site restaurant which judges and exhibitors like.

Class list: moved ranch conformation and ranch pleasure for flow. Pleasure can show around trail obstacles so there is no need for a break in between. Ranch conformation needs to be after western riding in case some of those exhibitors want to ride in the western riding. Conformation has to be after all the other ranch classes. We had a lot of discussion about this. The order of 13 and under and novice amateur classes will be switched due to patterns being the

same for both novice youth and novice amateur. We will be offering open classes as all ages instead of junior and senior. Class list must go to APHA 30 days before the show. We discussed special awards for 4-H and OHSET members. Discussed offering Jackpot classes. We will advertise these as added money and will need to find sponsors for these classes. The classes for 2024 will be walk trot HUS, pleasure, eq, horsemanship and showmanship. There will also be loping/canter jackpot classes as well in the same events. For showmanship the pattern will not be given out ahead of time. The eq and horsemanship will be run like a judges command class. We need to have an award presentation for each class and neck ribbons. This was tabled until September. We discussed having a silent auction at the show and having it as a youth fundraiser for youth scholarships for the 2025 show. This was tabled until the September meeting. Fee Schedule - tabled until September

Year End Award/Banquet:

Kristen has updated points for year end and emailed all exhibitors that are up for year end high point awards and sent membership forms to them. Kristen will send points to Brenda for the website and follow up with Brenda regarding other website information. Superhorse year end award will be blanket/sheet/sleezy in the exhibitor's choice of color and size. This award will be based on one horse any rider and only APHA classes count. The October show is OPHC approved and has two judges.

New/Other Business:

Partnering with SWWPHC for the spring show. We are asking SWWPHC to come up with a proposal to bring to the next meeting regarding partnering with them and what that looks like.
