SNOWBLOWER SEASONAL SERVICE

Starting at \$85 plus supplies & HST. Varies by make/model, but can include:

1. Inspect auger belt condition (cracks, burns etc.).
2. Adjust auger controls as required.
3. Inspect skid shoe condition and set to proper height.
4. Inspect scraper blade condition (wear).
5. Inspect auger / impeller housing (bends, holes, rust etc).
6. Inspect augers / impeller / shear pins / bolts (broken / bent parts).
7. Lubricate auger shaft / bearings / bushings as required.
8. Check impeller shaft support bearing / bushing for wear.
9. Check discharge chute and chute deflector condition (damaged parts).
10. Lubricate discharge chute and deflector rotating / pivot points as needed.
11. Check electrical items for proper operation (headlight, stop switch, safety key, etc.).
12. Check spark plug condition (replace if required)
13. Drain carburetor fuel bowl of sediment (determined by model).
14. Check fuel start up parts for proper operation (primer, choke etc).
15. Check fuel tank / line condition (cracks, holes, leaks etc).
16. Change engine oil (up to 1 liter of 5w30 engine oil included in service).
17. Inspect recoil and electric start operation and condition.
18. Inspect traction drive parts (bushings, bearings, chains, friction discs, hydrostatic components, tires, shafts etc).
19. Adjust traction drive controls as required (speed, engagement etc.)
20. Clean friction drive parts as required.
21. Lubricate drive parts as required.
22. Set tire pressures to spec (track / airless – check condition).

- 23. Inspect drive belt condition (cracks, burns etc.).
- 24. Check all control cables (damaged cable ends, housings, etc.).
- 25. Lubricate control cables and levers as required by model.
- 26. TEST OPERATION.
