# TUITION

The tuition charged pays for the salaries of our teachers and assistants. Please be prompt in paying your child's tuition. There is also a MANDATORY, one time annual fee of \$10 for school insurance. Please include this with your first tuition payment.

## TUITION AMOUNTS

2 Year Old Class - \$160.00 (2 days per week, Mon & Tues or Wed & Thu)

3 Year Old Class - \$200.00 (4 days per week, Mon - Thu)

4 Year Old Class - \$200.00 (4 days per week, Mon - Thu)

Tuition is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. After the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month, tuition will be considered LATE, and a \$30.00 late fee will be added to your balance. If tuition is TWO months late, this will result in your child's dismissal from the Day School. There is a \$30.00 fee on any returned checks. We are now encouraging the option of an **automatic bank draft**. Please inquire about this with your bank if you are interested. If you choose to pay with **cash**, please put it in an envelope with your name written clearly on the front. Make your check payable to St. Peter's Dayschool.

# RULES & REGULATIONS

## **Inclement Weather Policies**

1. Cancellation of the Dayschool due to inclement weather or uncontrollable circumstances may be made up at the discretion of the board.
2. We will follow the Beaufort County School system procedures for inclement weather, and they are as follows:
  - If there is a 1 hour delay, St. Peter's will still open at 9:00am
  - If there is a 2 hour delay, St. Peter's will open at 10:00am
  - If there is an early dismissal during Dayschool hours, St. Peter's will dismiss 30 minutes earlier (e.g. If BCS dismiss at 12:00p, we will dismiss at 11:30a)
  - PLEASE listen to your local T.V. or radio stations for details and update

## **Drop-off and Pick-up Policies**

- Please follow these procedures for drop and pick-up.
- Drop-off starts at 8:50 and will end at 9:10 each day. Please be prompt.
  - Use Bonner Street entrance (NOT 2<sup>nd</sup> Street).
  - Proceed with CAUTION through the parking lot in the right-hand lane. An assistant will be visible to greet your child.
  - Drivers, please stand outside your car on the passenger side and wait for assistant.
  - After 9:10 a.m., the Dayschool doors will be locked.
  - Pick-up is at 12:00 noon. Please be prompt.
  - Do not park and walk up to get your child. A teacher will walk up to your car with your child. Drivers, please stand outside your car on the passenger side and wait for assistant. Driver will secure the child into the car seat.
  - Exit safely, staying in right hand lane. Do not pass. Be patient as you wait.
  - At 12:20 p.m., if your child has not yet been picked up, a late fee of \$5.00 will be added to your tuition payment.  
This is for the health and safety of everyone.
  - Children will only be released to parents or designated adults listed on the registration form. If someone different will be picking up your child, please call or text the teacher, or send a note. Inform all drivers of our procedures.
  - Parents/caretakers will be responsible for securing your child into his/her car seat.
  - Please try to make appointments for your child before or after school hours, if possible. Late arrivals and early dismissals are discouraged.
  - If you need to speak to a teacher, please call or text the teacher, not the assistant, to make an appointment.

### **Illness Policies**

- For the well-being of your child and that of the other children in the classroom, any child with the following symptoms **MUST** be kept home until the symptoms disappear or until otherwise instructed by a medical professional:
  - Temperature of 100.4 or higher
  - Diarrhea within the last 24 hours
  - Severe coughing (child gets red in the face or produces whooping or croupy noise after coughing)
  - Pink eye
  - Thick green mucous, thick runny nose
  - Vomiting within the last 24 hours
- If your child becomes sick during school, you will be contacted to come pick your child up. Your child will be placed into isolation with a teacher until you arrive.
- If your child arrives at school sick, you will be asked to take your child home.
- Upon arrival, if your child has a temperature of 100.4 or higher, your child may not attend school that day. Your child may not return to school until he/she has been fever-free for 24 hours (with no fever reducing medications.)

### **Immunization Policies**

- We recommend all children attending St. Peter's Dayschool be up to date on all childhood immunizations. A copy of the immunization record should be given to your child's teacher.

### **Health and Cleanliness**

- Toys will be kept to a minimum in each classroom. Toys will be rotated and sanitized by staff daily. Tables, chairs, and cubbies will be cleaned as well.
- We will provide each child with their own crayons and paints. These items will not be sent home and will not be shared among the class.
- Each child will have their own cubbie, located in the hall or the classroom. Book bags, totes, and supplies will be kept inside cubbies. These spaces will be sanitized regularly.
- Each class has a designated time for playground use each day. This area will be sanitized regularly.

### **Discipline Policies**

Children learn self-control when adults treat them with dignity. Positive Christian guidance techniques used in the classroom include guiding children through modeling and encouraging expected behaviors by setting rules for classroom behavior; listening when children talk about their feelings and frustrations; and encouraging cooperation and respect among all children.

- Consequences for misbehavior include the following:
  - Time out with teacher conference - consists of taking the child out or away from the activity for a small amount of time (depending on age of the child).
  - Parent will be called by the teacher or a note will be sent home informing the parent of the child's behavior (the note should be signed and returned to the teacher the following day).
  - Parent will observe the child in the classroom setting upon request of the child's teacher.
  - Parent/teacher and/or director conference. If at any time there should be a need for a conference, there will be two staff members in attendance (teacher, assistants, and/or the director).
  - As a last resort, suspension from the Dayschool. The length of time will depend on the disciplinary problem. This will be decided upon and recommended by the Board of Directors for St. Peter's Dayschool.

### **Special Needs Policies**

- If your child is identified as having a special need, or you suspect that your child has some special need(s), it is our wish to be involved in the process or processes of identification of the needs, sharing in the evaluations that are completed, and openly speaking with you as parents or guardians, as well as, the service providers who work with your child.
- The Dayschool Board reserves the right to decline or discontinue the enrollment of any child whose needs are determined to be greater than the Dayschool's capabilities to serve.

### **Classroom and Other School Policies**

- Snacks are to be provided by the parents. Your child's teacher will let you know when it is your turn. Food should be store bought only and individually packaged.
- Birthday snacks may be sent into the school by your child.
- Do not send birthday invitations to school unless you have one for each child in the class.
- Do not send birthday presents to school.
- Do not send toys to school.
- Write your child's name on all belongings.
- Send a regular-sized book bag or tote to school with your child. Label each item. (This includes book bags and totes.)

Please contact your child's teacher or one of the board members if you have concerns or questions. We cannot correct problems if we are not aware of them. We also appreciate positive feedback.
