

The Children, Young People, and Families Manager apprenticeship is a Level 5 qualification designed for those in, or aspiring to, leadership roles within social care, youth services, or family support settings. This programme prepares managers to lead teams and develop services that provide high-quality support to children, young people, and families, promoting their well-being, safety, and personal development. This apprenticeship is ideal for experienced practitioners ready to step into management roles or for current managers wanting to strengthen their skills. It suits those dedicated to making a lasting impact on young lives by shaping and leading high-quality support services. Successful completion can lead to roles such as Team Leader, Service Manager, or Family Support Manager.

1 Entry Requirements

You must have been a UK, EEA, or EU resident for at least the three years before starting the apprenticeship.

You must be employed in a relevant job role and able to commit to the full length of the programme including the End Point Assessment.

If you do not have GCSE grade C/4 or equivalent in Maths and English, you will be required to work towards achieving these qualifications as part of your apprenticeship.

Reviews & Teaching and Learning

Each month, a trainer will conduct a teaching and learning session with the Apprentice to ensure their ongoing development. Additionally, every other month, the trainer will visit to meet with both the Apprentice and the Employer for a comprehensive review of progress and performance.

4 End Point Assessment

The End-Point Assessment (EPA) is comprised of two components: Ongoing Support: Provided by Training Works

- Situational Judgment Test:
 - 120 minutes
 - Graded as Pass or Fail
- Competence Interview.
 - o Duration: 60 minutes
 - Graded as Pass or Distinction
