The Level 2 Healthcare Support Worker Apprenticeship is designed for individuals beginning a career in healthcare. The programme develops the practical skills and knowledge needed to provide safe, compassionate care while supporting patients with their daily needs and promoting their health and wellbeing. Apprentices learn how to work effectively as part of a healthcare team in settings such as hospitals, GP practices, clinics, or community services. This apprenticeship is ideal for those looking to start a rewarding career in healthcare. Roles can lead into Senior Healthcare Support Worker, specialist healthcare support roles, or further healthcare training.

1 Entry Requirements

You must have been a UK, EEA, or EU resident for at least the three years before starting the apprenticeship.

You must be employed in a relevant job role and able to commit to the full length of the programme including the End Point Assessment.

If you do not have GCSE grade C/4 or equivalent in Maths and English, you may be required to work towards achieving these qualifications as part of your apprenticeship.

3 Reviews & Teaching and Learning

Each month, a trainer will conduct a teaching and learning session with the Apprentice to ensure their ongoing development. Additionally, every other month, the trainer will visit to meet with both the Apprentice and the Employer for a comprehensive review of progress and performance.

4 End Point Assessment

The End-Point Assessment (EPA) is comprised of three components: Ongoing Support: Provided by Training Works

- Written Self-Assessment: Reflect on your own knowledge, skills, and behaviors.
- Observation:
 - Duration: 90 Minutes Observation
 - 30 Minutes Questions
- Professional Discussion:
 - Duration: 60 minutes
