The Adult Care Worker Level 2 Apprenticeship provides a comprehensive introduction to the essential skills and knowledge required for a successful career in adult care. This course is designed for those who are new to the sector or seeking to formalize their experience with a recognised qualification. Apprentices will gain a solid understanding of key areas including personal care, safeguarding, health and safety, and effective communication. The program combines hands-on practical experience with theoretical learning, enabling learners to develop the competence and confidence needed to support individuals in various care settings. Through a blend of on-the-job training and guided instruction, the Level 2 Apprenticeship equips learners with the foundation to progress in their careers and make a meaningful impact in the field of adult care.

1 Entry Requirements

You must have been a UK, EEA, or EU resident for at least the three years before starting the apprenticeship.

You must be employed in a relevant job role and able to commit to the full length of the programme including the End Point Assessment.

If you do not have GCSE grade C/4 or equivalent in Maths and English, you will be required to work towards achieving these qualifications as part of your apprenticeship.

3 Reviews & Teaching and Learning

Each month, a trainer will conduct a teaching and learning session with the Apprentice to ensure their ongoing development. Additionally, every other month, the trainer will visit to meet with both the Apprentice and the Employer for a comprehensive review of progress and performance.

4 End Point Assessment

The End-Point Assessment (EPA) is comprised of three components: Ongoing Support: Provided by Training Works

- Written Self-Assessment: Reflect on your own knowledge, skills, and behaviors.
- Situational Judgment Test:
 - 60 questions
 - 90 minutes
 - Graded as Pass, Merit, or Distinction
- Professional Discussion:
 - Duration: 45 minutes
 - Graded as Pass, Merit, or Distinction
