

The Early Years Practitioner apprenticeship is a Level 2 qualification designed for those working with young children from birth to 5 years old in settings such as nurseries, pre-schools, and early years centres. It focuses on developing essential skills to support children's development, learning, and well-being. This apprenticeship is ideal for those new to early years care or wishing to start a career working with young children. It suits individuals who are passionate about child development and want to gain practical experience while achieving a formal qualification. It provides a foundation for progressing to higher-level early years qualifications.

### **1** Entry Requirements

You must have been a UK, EEA, or EU resident for at least the three years before starting the apprenticeship.

You must be employed in a relevant job role and able to commit to the full length of the programme including the End Point Assessment.

If you do not have GCSE grade C/4 or equivalent in Maths and English, you will be required to work towards achieving these qualifications as part of your apprenticeship

## **3** Reviews & Teaching and Learning

Each month, a trainer will conduct a teaching and learning session with the Apprentice to ensure their ongoing development. Additionally, every other month, the trainer will visit to meet with both the Apprentice and the Employer for a comprehensive review of progress and performance.

## 4 End Point Assessment

The End-Point Assessment (EPA) is comprised of two components: Ongoing Support: Provided by Training Works

- Multiple Choice Knowledge Test:
  - 40 questions
  - 60 minutes
  - Graded as Pass or Distinction
- Professional Discussion:
  - Duration: 90 minutes
  - Graded as Pass or Distinction
