

The Leader in Adult Care apprenticeship is a Level 5 qualification aimed at individuals aspiring to or currently in managerial roles within adult care settings, such as care homes, domiciliary care, and community care services. It focuses on leadership and management skills, ensuring the delivery of high-quality, person-centred care. This apprenticeship is ideal for senior care professionals, deputy managers, or aspiring care managers who want to advance into leadership roles. It suits those looking to lead in adult care services, manage teams, and take responsibility for the overall quality of care provision.

1 Entry Requirements

You must have been a UK, EEA, or EU resident for at least the three years before starting the apprenticeship.

You must be employed in a relevant job role and able to commit to the full length of the programme including the End Point Assessment.

If you do not have GCSE grade C/4 or equivalent in Maths and English, you will be required to work towards achieving these qualifications as part of your apprenticeship.

3 Reviews & Teaching and Learning

Each month, a trainer will conduct a teaching and learning session with the Apprentice to ensure their ongoing development. Additionally, every other month, the trainer will visit to meet with both the Apprentice and the Employer for a comprehensive review of progress and performance.

4 End Point Assessment

The End-Point Assessment (EPA) is comprised of two components: Ongoing Support: Provided by Training Works

- Observation of Practice
 - Duration: 90 minutes with 15 minute Q&A session after.
 - Graded as Pass or Fail
- Professional Discussion:
 - Duration: 90 minutes
 - Graded as Pass or Distinction

5 Cost

Apprentices aged 22+ = £350pp
