The Teaching Assistant Level 3 Apprenticeship is a qualification for individuals who already have experience supporting teaching and learning and who wish to take on greater responsibility within school settings. This programme focuses on developing advanced skills in helping pupils of all ages and abilities, supporting classroom management, and contributing to high-quality teaching and learning. This apprenticeship is ideal for classroom assistants, learning support assistants, or support staff who want to progress in their role and strengthen their impact on pupils' learning and development. It suits those who are passionate about supporting children's education, working collaboratively with teachers, and fostering a positive, inclusive learning environment. This qualification can lead to roles such as Teaching Assistant, Learning Support Assistant, or Higher Level Teaching Assistant, and can support progression into further education or specialist support roles within schools.

1 Entry Requirements

You must have been a UK, EEA, or EU resident for at least the three years before starting the apprenticeship.

You must be employed in a relevant job role and able to commit to the full length of the programme including the End Point Assessment.

If you do not have GCSE grade C/4 or equivalent in Maths and English, you may be required to work towards achieving these qualifications as part of your apprenticeship.

3 Reviews & Teaching and Learning

Each month, a trainer will conduct a teaching and learning session with the Apprentice to ensure their ongoing development. Additionally, every other month, the trainer will visit to meet with both the Apprentice and the Employer for a comprehensive review of progress and performance.

The End-Point Assessment (EPA) is comprised of three components: Ongoing Support: Provided by Training Works

- Professional Discussion:
 - Duration: 90 minutes
