Occupational progression map



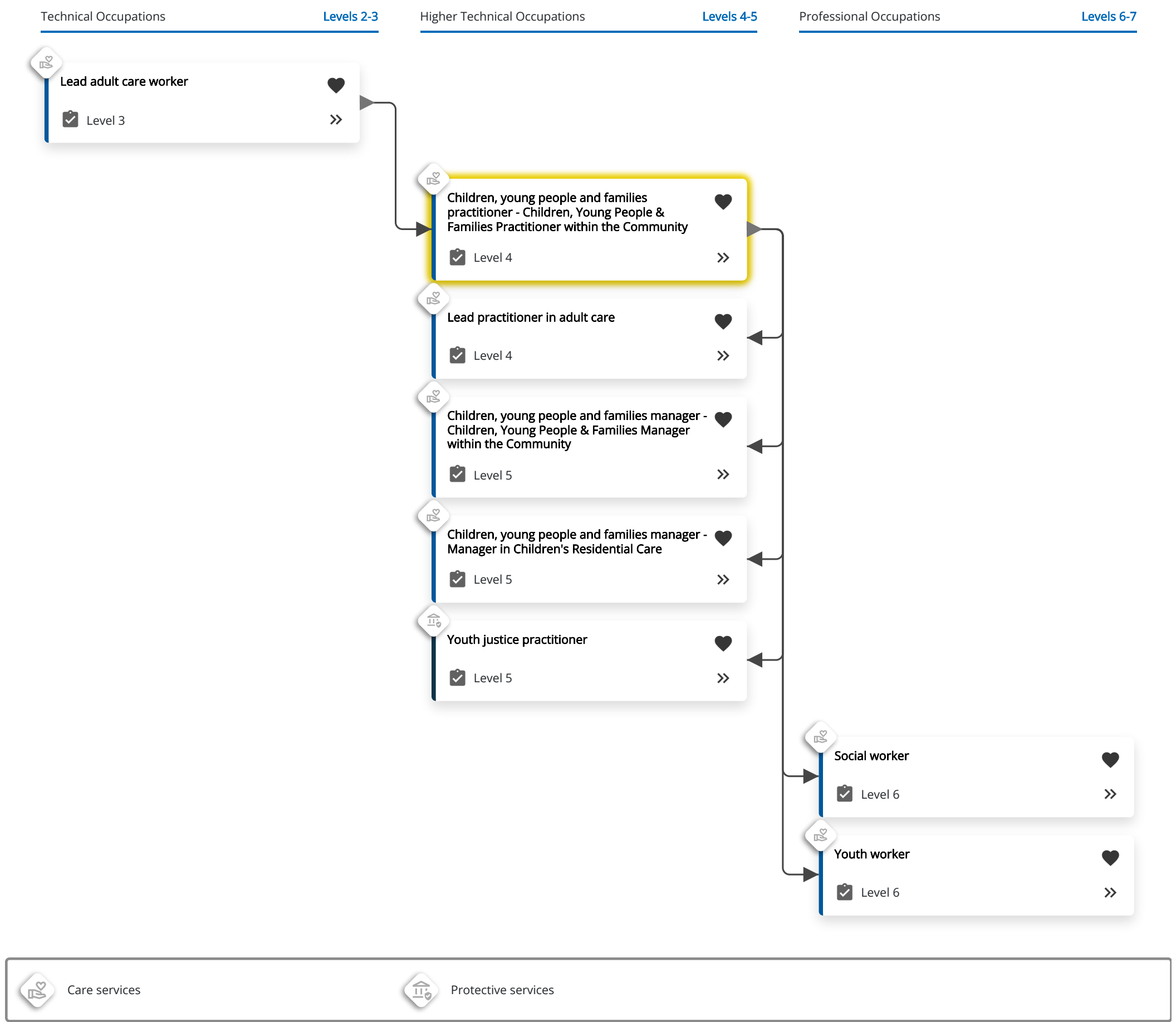
Children, young people and families practitioner - Children, Young People & Families Practitioner within the Community Progression Map


This occupational progression map shows technical occupations that have transferable knowledge and skills.


In this map, the focused occupation is highlighted in yellow. The arrows indicate where transferable knowledge and skills exist between two occupations. This map shows some of the strongest progression links between the focused occupation and other occupations.
