

**NOTICE OF FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT AND
NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST RELEASE OF FUNDS**

These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the City of Kirbyville.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about April 20th, 2026 the City of Kirbyville will submit a request to the Texas General Land Office for the release of Community Development Block Grant CDBG-MIT funds appropriated under the Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Requirements Act, 2018 (Pub. L. 115-123), as amended, to undertake a project known as Kirbyville 24-065-160-F075 - Sewer Improvements. The City of Kirbyville proposes to install sewer lines and manholes; repair roadways; and complete associated appurtenances. This project is a non-critical action project and does not require acquisition. If utility conflicts are encountered during construction, they will be relocated within existing rights-of-way and in areas already cleared through the environmental review process; if relocation is required in areas not previously cleared, an environmental re-evaluation will be conducted prior to construction. Construction will take place in the following locations within the City of Kirbyville, Jasper County, Texas. Please see project maps for Area of Potential Effect (APE).

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The City of Kirbyville has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. All comments received by April 17st, 2026 will be considered by the City of Kirbyville prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.


ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The City of Kirbyville certifies to the Texas General Land Office that Frank George in their capacity as Mayor consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. Texas General Land Office approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows the City of Kirbyville to use HUD program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

The Texas General Land Office will accept objections to its release of funds and the City of Kirbyville's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the City of Kirbyville approved by the Texas General Land Office (b) the City of Kirbyville has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs, or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by the Texas General Land Office; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to Heather Lagrone, the Texas General Land Office – Community Development and Revitalization at P.O. Box 12873, Austin, Texas 78711-2873, env.reviews@recovery.texas.gov. Potential objectors should contact the Texas General Land Office to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
