AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RESULTS OF A GENERAL ELECTION HELD FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING CANDIDATES TO THE OFFICE OF COUNCILMEMBER PLACE 1, COUNCILMEMBER PLACE 2, COUNCILMEMBER PLACE 5, AND VOTING FOR OR AGAINST PROPOSITION A, ¼ .25 SALES AND USE TAX FOR STREET MAINTENANCE, HAVING BEEN HELD ON MAY 07, 2022; DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THAT ELECTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
