2022 CLASSIC FORMAT OF PLAY

The Medinah Classic Tournament is a three-day event using all three courses

The field will be split into three flights using total handicap index. The low third will be in the Red Flight, the middle third will be in the Green Flight, and the final third will be in the White Flight. Teams will compete within flights for daily prizes and to determine the overall champions.

Starting times and pairings for Thursday & Friday will be assigned by the professional staff before the tournament, and then the total score of the first two days will determine starting times for Saturday's Final Round. Tee times on Saturday will begin at 7:30 a.m. Times will be determined based on each team's two-day total and will be assigned from high to low. Saturday morning tee times will be announced by 8 p.m. Friday evening via email.

Thursday, August 4 - One Net Best Ball and Alternate Nines

Red Flight	Course #1
Green Flight	Course #2
White Flight	Course #3

Each team will play an 18-hole One Net Best Ball. In addition, both players must contribute a 9-hole net score. If player one uses his 9-hole net score on the front, then player two must use his 9-hole net score on the back. Teams do not have to decide which nines to use until completion of play. These nines will then be added together for an 18-hole total. Therefore, each team will post a 36-hole score.

Friday, August 5 - Half Combined Net & Best Ball

Red Flight	Course #2
Green Flight	Course #3
White Flight	Course #1

Each team will take half of their net team score and add it to their net best ball score to come up with a total for the round.

Saturday, August 6 - Total Combined Net & Best-Ball

Red Flight	Course #3
Green Flight	Course #1
White Flight	Course #2

Each team will combine their net scores with their net best ball score to produce a total score for the day. Please remember these scores are added to essentially get a 54-hole score.

2022 CLASSIC HANDICAP POLICY

- Any player shooting a score that is greater than 500:1 odds for their handicap will have their handicap cut by the amount to get them back in compliance
- Example: When a player with a 10 handicap plays a course with a course rating of 72, his best 10 out of 20 scores will average 82. The odds of that player shooting a 76 on that course would be 536:1. If he does shoot 76, he will be cut 1 stroke per round, in order to get him below the 500:1 odds of occurrence.
- Remember, your handicap represents your 'potential' to score a good round. For most players, your AVERAGE score is going to be 2-4 strokes higher than your handicap.
- The player shall continue with the revised handicap for the rest of the Tournament.
- In the event a player does get cut, the Director of Golf will notify the individual.
- Listed below is the chart from the 'Pope of Slope', showing odds of score occurrence.

Any player shooting a net score that falls into the 'yellow' area of odds occurrence will be cut the appropriate number of strokes to make that player into compliance. The Handicap Committee has the discretion to make a handicap adjustment at any time.

All handicap related decisions are made to protect the integrity of the event and will be screened by the Handicap Committee, Director of Golf, and the Classic Committee.

2022 MEDINAH CLASSIC AWARDS

Overall Medinah Classic Champion in each flight will be team with the lowest three-day total score

If there is a tie for any daily positions within a flight, the tie will be broken by comparing one net best ball score for that day. If the teams are still tied, the tie will be broken by comparing scorecards from the 1st hole going forward in a sudden death playoff using a one net best ball from Round 3. All ties for the overall flight winners and runners-up of the Classic will be broken by comparing scorecards from the 1st hole going forward in a sudden death playoff using a one NET best ball from round 3.

2022 Classic Special Prizes: 'Hole-in-Ones'

A cash prize will be awarded to the first player to hit a hole in one on the following holes:

Course #1	18th Hole	\$10,000
Course #2	8th Hole	\$10,000
Course #3	17th Hole	\$10,000

Individual Closest to the Pin

A prize will be awarded to the player for 'Closest-to-the-Pin', including his teammate, on every Par 3 each day, even the hole-in-one prize holes.

Cash Game

Entry Fee: \$375 cash per team

Fee Breakdown: \$100 per day, plus \$25 for Team Skins Per Day





Incident Weather

Subject to change by Tournament Committee

In the case of lightning or severe weather, the signal to halt play is a continuous siren; the signal to resume play is an intermittent siren.

In the case of a significant delay, resumption of play and event format may be adjusted for the integrity of the event. All decisions will be made by the Classic Committee with consultation of the Professional Staff based on the conditions presented.
