Day 9 Full Day Tour To Ba Na Hills, French Village And Golden Hands Bridge

After breakfast at your hotel, you'll be picked up for an exciting day at Ba Na Hills. Begin your journey with a scenic cable car ride to Ba Na Hills, where you'll be amazed by breathtaking views and the world-record-setting cable car route. Once at the top, explore the iconic Golden Bridge, a 150-meter-long pedestrian bridge held up by massive hands, an architectural marvel. Visit the enchanting Le Jardin, which reflects the French colonial heritage of the area. You can also visit the historic Debay Wine Cellar as an optional experience, available for direct payment. Then, proceed to Linh Ung Pagoda, home to a towering 27-meter Buddha statue, and explore the peaceful Loc Uyen Garden and Quan Am Cac. For adventure lovers, Fantasy Park awaits, with thrilling rides such as the Love Swing, Skiver Pilot, Fire Racing Track, Bumper Cars, and Ghost House. Enjoy a buffet-style lunch before taking a scenic trek to the Peak of Chua Mountain at 1,487 meters, where you can visit the Ba Chua Thuong Ngan Temple and take in panoramic views of Da Nang City and Da Nang Bay. Afterward, return to Da Nang for some free time to explore local shops and pick up souvenirs, capturing the essence of Vietnam. In the late afternoon, you'll be dropped off at your hotel in Da Nang to relax and retreat on the incredible day spent at Ba Na Hills.

The Chairman Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (Vietnamese: Lăng Chủ tịch Hồ Chí Minh) is a mausoleum which serves as the resting place of Vietnamese Revolutionary leader Ho Chi Minh in Hanoi, Vietnam. It is a large building located in the center of Ba Dinh Square, where Ho, Chairman of the Workers' Party of Vietnam from 1951 until his death in 1969, read the Declaration of Independence on 2 September 1945, establishing the Democratic Republic of Vietnam. It is also known as Ba Đình Mausoleum (Vietnamese: Lăng Ba Đình) and is open to the public. Note: The Mausoleum just opens in early morning, except Monday and Friday

Temple of Literature & National University

It is one of several temples in Vietnam which is dedicated to Confucius, sages and scholars. The temple is located to the south of the Imperial Citadel of Thăng Long. The various pavilions, halls, statues and stelae of doctors are places where offering ceremonies, study sessions and the strict exams of the Đại Việt took place. The temple is featured on the back of the 100,000 Vietnamese đồng banknote
