Upcoming Residents Meetings

Meetings are held on the second Thursday of each month except July and August, at 8:00 pm in the Clubhouse. Attendance by the Board of Directors is mandatory, but all residents are encouraged to attend. Mark your calendar for the next three scheduled meeting dates which are February 9th, March 9th and April 13th.

ONGOING NEED FOR STREET REPS

Every resident in Florida Gardens is a member of the Florida Gardens Civic Association, Inc. The Association is governed by a representative Board of Directors, which consists of five elected Officers, three appointed Directors at Large, and 19 Street Representatives. The Street Reps are the voice of the residents. Their input helps shape the function, activities and direction of the Community. Without their representation, the residents have no voice. But as critical as the position of Street Rep is, it takes very little time or effort. You don't even have to be a resident of the street you represent (although that is always the preference). The 'duties' of a Street Rep are simple and outlined in the By-Laws. First, since you represent the residents, attend the monthly Residents Meeting. There are only 10 per year (we don't meet in July or August) and last about an hour or less. There can even be two people acting as a Street Rep for a street - a Primary and a Secondary so if one can't make it the other can take their place. Second, the Street Rep is responsible for insuring that the community Newsletter, published 5 times per year, gets delivered to all the houses on their street. This doesn't mean you have to do it yourself (but it is a good way to connect with the people you represent). If necessary, you can find someone to do it for you. Your responsibility is simply that it gets done. That's about it. So why, with an average of about 44 houses per street, is it so difficult to find a few people willing and able to support this community by filling the pending Street Rep vacancies? If this simple but vital activity is something you would be willing to volunteer for, please contact Mike Misko. Get involved in your Community.

ENTRANCE SIGN RECONSTRUCTION AND AREA CLEAN-UP

During December, Clubhouse Manager Terry Ann Crosby led a small group of volunteers who addressed the deteriorating condition of the entrance sign area on Ohio Road. Also, please note that the Association must pay a processing fee for contributions made online or through VENMO.

Traffic Light Changes may be coming at Lake Worth Road / Ohio Road

UPDATE - In the November Newsletter I reported on my efforts to have the traffic signals at the Ohio Road / Lake Worth Road intersection modified to reduce the number of accidents there caused by drivers turning left from both Ohio and Nassau Roads in conflict with drivers going straight across the intersection, all on simultaneous green lights. The report I generated and sent to the County with a recommendation for modification of the traffic signals was approved by the County Traffic Engineering Department and has been forwarded to the Florida Department of Transportation for their review, since Lake Worth Road is a State road under their jurisdiction. As of this writing, the engineers at FDOT are investigating whether the traffic signal arms presently there are sufficient to hold the weight of the new signals that would be required for the change.

SAFETY WALKING AT NIGHT

FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY - PLEASE! Earlier this month, I encountered a person walking their dog at night on the road wearing all dark clothing and walking a black dog. With an oncoming car at the same time, it was impossible to see them until the last minute. Some reasonable suggestions for anyone out walking at night: 1) Wear bright clothing and better yet one of those reflective safety vests. 2) Walk facing oncoming traffic. If there are no sidewalks, Florida law 316.130(4) specifies that pedestrians must walk on the shoulder of the road AGAINST the flow of traffic. 3) Carry a flashlight. 4) When you have a vehicle approaching, get well off the road until the vehicle passes. 5) Be very careful around the numerous package delivery vehicles now making night deliveries. Please make an extra effort to stay safe walking at night. Many drivers don't slow down and pleas to do so, especially at night, fall on deaf ears. Pedestrians may have the legal right-of-way, but there's an old saying about being "dead right".




