

ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION STATUS



In the January Newsletter, we kicked off our annual contribution drive. We detailed how your contributions fund the various community activities and children's holiday parties. We asked that you check with your friends that live in HOA communities and see what they pay annually in mandatory HOA dues and what they receive in return. We also have a safe, simple method to make a contribution online through our website or even on your phone if you have the Venmo app if a mailed check is too inconvenient.

As of March 10th, only 104 of our 782 households in Florida Gardens have recognized the need for their involvement and have been generous enough to contribute. Most have contributed \$50. Some have contributed more. To everyone who has contributed thus far, we say THANK YOU!

RECIPE OF THE MONTH (HAVEN'T DONE ONE OF THESE IN A WHILE)

APPLE-WALNUT PORK TENDERLOIN

1-1/2 lbs pork tenderloin 1 large garlic clove 1/4 teaspoon salt

1/2 cup chopped walnuts 1 tablespoon olive oil 1/4 teaspoon pepper

1 cup chopped apples 2 tablespoons margarine 2 tablespoons flour

1 cup bread cubes 2 teaspoons lemon juice sour cream, if desired

1/2 cup chopped onion 1/2 teaspoon dried thyme leaves

Split the tenderloin lengthwise, but not completely through. Flatten meat and rub with garlic. Place in a roasting pan. Mince the garlic clove. In a skillet, heat margarine. Saute onion and garlic. Stir in walnuts, bread cubes, apples, thyme, salt and pepper. Stuff tenederloin with mixture. Tie with string or skewer. Any leftover stuffing can be spooned around the pork in the roasting pan. Rub pork with oil and lemon juice. Place in pre-heated 450-degree oven. Turn heat down to 325-degrees and bake for 3/4 to 1 hour. Check meat for tenderness. Make pan gravy by blending flour into 2 table-spoons of drippings in pan. Stir in enough water or broth to make about 1 cup gravy. Stir in a little sour cream, if desired. Serve with vegetable of choice.
