The Danger Electric Vehicles Pose to Pedestrians and Bicyclists

Lisa suggests that if you are driving an electric vehicle through the neighborhood and you see people walking, kids playing or someone biking, a tap on the car horn might help prevent an accident. [Editors note:] Electric vehicles, including electric golf carts, are very quiet. Studies have shown that electric vehicles are 37 percent more likely to cause pedestrian collisions and 57 percent more likely to cause bicycle collisions than vehicles that use louder gas engines. As mentioned in the article in our January 2023 Newsletter, on streets with no sidewalks, pedestrians must always walk facing traffic as specified by Florida law.

As far back as 20 years ago, with the advent of the Toyota Prius, lawmakers recognized the potential danger to pedestrians and bicyclists from "silent cars", and continue to this day to try and legislate a solution. One such (laughable) proposed regulation requires that electric vehicles actually be required to generate a sound when traveling below 19 mph. This however wouldn't help much in Florida Gardens where vehicles routinely travel in excess of the 30 mph posted limit. Lisa's 'horn tap' suggestion might be the best solution to help keep pedestrians and bicyclists in Florida Gardens safe from ALL vehicles.

Your transaction is secured through PayPal, but you do NOT need to have a PayPal account. Enter the contribution amount and select either PayPal or your own credit card. Traffic Light Changes Coming at Lake Worth Road / Ohio Road - UPDATE

In several previous issues of this Newsletter I have reported on my efforts to have the traffic signals at the Ohio Road / Lake Worth Road intersection modified to reduce the number of accidents caused by drivers turning left from both Ohio and Nassau Roads in conflict with drivers going straight across the intersection, all on simultaneous green lights. This effort started in September 2022 (!) with a report I generated and sent to the County with a recommendation for modification of the traffic signals to implement dedicated left-turn arrows for the turn lanes similar to most other intersections. County Traffic Engineering opted for flashing yellow arrows to simply alert drivers that the vehicles in the turn lane needed to yield to the vehicles coming straight across the intersection. It was not what I had hoped for, but was better than nothing. Their proposal was forwarded to the Florida Department of Transportation for their review, since Lake Worth Road is a State road under their jurisdiction. They approved the change in February 2023. The next step was for engineers at FDOT to investigate whether the current traffic signal arms were sufficient to hold the weight of the new signals that would be required for the change. They were! The project was then finally released to a contractor in December. NOW it has been reported that the signal controller (that big silver box by the side of the road) was too old to implement the County's flashing yellow arrow idea. They deemed it too costly to replace the controller and are now looking to pursue implementing my ORIGINAL request to install dedicated green turn arrows for the turn lanes (apparently the old controller can accommodate that). The project has now been sent BACK to Palm Beach County Traffic Engineering for their approval (recall that they rejected the green arrows and opted for the flashing yellow ones). I have enlisted the help of County Commissioner Barnett whose office has been in contact with Traffic Engineering. We will see what happens next in the now 18-month struggle to reduce the accidents at this dangerous intersection.

UPDATE ON SPEED BUMPS ALONG SPRINGDALE ROAD.

There has always been a problem with Lucerne Lakes residents using Springdale Road and the connection into Lucerne Lakes via Columbia Road as a way to avoid traffic and traffic lights on Lake Worth Road. There have often been complaints of speeding along Springdale. The problem will be exacerbated by the additional residents introduced by the golf course conversion.

When the golf course conversion was proposed 3 years ago, we made Mattamy Homes, the developer, aware of this concern. To help alleviate the problem their development will create, they agreed to fund the installation of two speed bumps on Springdale Road.

Now that the litigation between Mattamy and the Lucerne Lakes HOA is over and the development is proceeding, we have presented our proposal for the location of the two speed bumps (see the map on the front page of the January Newsletter).

It is hoped that the addition of these two speed bumps will reduce the dangerous speeding traffic along Springdale and perhaps even dissuade Lucerne Lakes residents from using Springdale as an alternative to Lake Worth Road. Please note that Palm Beach County Road and Bridge Division must approve the installation, so determining the proposed locations was simply the next step in the process that Mattamy Homes is taking to fulfil their commitment. Assuming they are approved by the County, Mattamy will install the speed bumps at the same time the southbound left turn lane to Columbia Road is added on Ohio Road.






