HONOR OUR VETERANS - Once again this year, on the Sunday before Memorial Day, volunteers will place flags on every one of the 30,000 graves currently in the South Florida National Cemetery on State Road 7. It's a massive effort. Drive through the cemetery some time during Memorial Day week to see all 30,000 headstones each adorned with an American flag and pay your respects. The flags are removed Saturday.

Just a reminder, per the U.S. Flag Code, on Memorial Day the flag is flown at half-staff until noon only, at which time it is raised to full-staff. We also honor the memory of our military heroes with a National Moment of Remembrance at 3:00 p.m, for one minute.

DRIVERS LICENSE TO BE REQUIRED FOR GOLF CART OPERATION

The Florida Legislature unanimously passed a law, effective October 1st, that requires the driver of a golf cart operated on <u>permitted</u> public roads who is 18 years old or younger to have a drivers license or, if accompanied by a licensed driver at least 21 years old, a drivers license learners permit. Golf cart drivers older than 18 need not be licensed but must have in their possession a state-issued I.D. card when operating one. Again, this law will take effect October 1st. Note that a registered and insured "street-legal" cart, properly called a Low Speed Vehicle (LSV) is a motor vehicle which always requires a driver's license (or learner's permit when accompanied) to operate. LSV's can be operated on any public roadway where the posted speed limit is 35 MPH or less.

So how will this new law affect Florida Gardens (if at all)? Well, for now, it doesn't.

A <u>regular golf cart</u> may NOT be operated by ANYONE upon a county road that has not been designated by the county for use by golf carts. We all know that many residents in Florida Gardens drive their golf carts around the neighborhood regularly. Once in a while, something bad happens and the Sheriff's Office is obligated to clamp down on their use by everyone (at least for a little while). A common sense solution would be to have the County designate Florida Gardens roads as being safe for golf carts which, when coupled with the new law requiring drivers to be licensed, would allow at least the opportunity for safe and legal operation of regular golf carts within Florida Gardens.

Before making such a designation, the County Road and Bridge Department must first determine that golf carts may safely travel on the public roads, considering factors including the speed, volume, and character of motor vehicle traffic using the roads. Upon a determination that golf carts may be safely operated on the designated roads, the County would post appropriate signs to indicate that such operation is allowed. We'll see how it goes.

Upcoming Residents Meetings

Meetings are held on the second Thursday of each month except July and August, at 8:00 pm in the Clubhouse. Attendance by the Board of Directors is mandatory, but all residents are encouraged to attend. Mark your calendar for the next scheduled meeting, which is June 8th. There are no meetings held in July or August.



ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION STATUS



In the January Newsletter, we kicked off our annual contribution drive. We detailed how your contributions fund the various community activities and children's holiday parties. We asked that you check with your friends that live in HOA communities and see what they pay annually in mandatory HOA dues and what they receive in return. We also have a safe, simple method to make a contribution online through our website or even on your phone if you have the Venmo app if a mailed check is too inconvenient.

To make your member contribution online with a credit card, go to - www.floridagardens.net - and select "CONTRIBUTE" in the top menu bar. Depending on your device, it may be located under "More". Your transaction is secured through PayPal, but you do NOT need to have a PayPal account. Enter the contribution amount and select either PayPal or your own credit card. After entering your credit card info, please <u>select the "Share your mailing address..." check box so we can properly record your contribution</u>. Also, please note that the Association must pay a processing fee for contributions made online or through VENMO.

OUR NEW DISTRICT 3 PALM BEACH COUNTY COMMISSIONER - MICHAEL BARNETT

The Board of County Commissioners serves as the legislative and policy-setting body for county government. Among other things, they also act as the Solid Waste Authority Governing Board and the Zoning Board. Seven commissioners are elected from single-member districts to staggered four-year terms to represent the entire county. During the first meeting of each month, with the exception of January and August, citizens may offer comments on any issue or topic during Matters by the Public.

The county is divided into seven districts. Florida Gardens is on the western border of District 3. Currently, our District Commissioner is Republican Michael A. Barnett. Commissioner Barnett was not elected but was appointed on January 5, 2023 by Governor DeSantis. He was appointed to fill the commission vacancy created when Gov. DeSantis tapped Commissioner Dave Kerner to lead the state Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles. The Commission, which was 6-1 Democratic before the 2022 election, now consists of 4 Republicans and 3 Democrats.
