## *Memorial Day - Monday, May 27<sup>th</sup>*

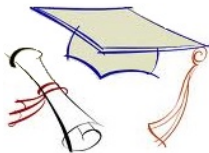
*Remember our fallen heroes. They are the reason we are free.*

**HONOR OUR VETERANS** - Once again this year, on the Sunday before Memorial Day, volunteers will place flags on every one of the 30,000 graves currently in the South Florida National Cemetery on State Road 7. It's a massive effort. Drive through the cemetery some time during Memorial Day week to see all 30,000 headstones each adorned with an American flag and pay your respects. The flags are removed Saturday.

Just a reminder, per the U.S. Flag Code, on Memorial Day the flag is flown at half-staff until noon only, at which time it is raised to full-staff. We also honor the memory of our military heroes with a National Moment of Remembrance at 3:00 p.m. for one minute.

Florida Gardens is a family community. Because we have a clubhouse facility, we have been able to have community events throughout the year. Besides our annual community gathering, the children really enjoy the Easter, Halloween and Christmas parties. All our residents have the clubhouse available to rent for their own special events. Plus, we open the facility to neighborhood support groups for weekly meetings. We also maintain the entrance sign on Ohio Road.

Through the Florida Gardens Civic Association, we provide deserving High School students with scholarship awards each year. We awarded two FG students \$1500 each in 2023.

Use the VENMO QR Code below to make a contribution with VENMO. Enter “@floridagardensca” as payee. If asked for the last four payee phone digits, enter 0541. Type your name and street address in the comments field so we can properly record your contribution.

Use the ZELLE QR Code below to make a contribution with ZELLE. Please type your name and address in the MEMO field so we can properly record your contribution.

To make your contribution online with a credit card, go to - [floridagardens.net](http://floridagardens.net) - and select “CONTRIBUTE” in the top menu bar. Depending on your device, it may be located under “More”. Your transaction is secured through PayPal, but you do NOT need to have a PayPal account. Enter the contribution amount and select either PayPal or your own credit card. After entering your credit card info, please select the "Share your mailing address..." check box so we can properly record your contribution. Also, please note that the Association must pay a processing fee for contributions made online through our website or through VENMO.

To contribute by check, use the coupon at the bottom of the next page and place both in an envelope. You can mail it (address on the coupon) or save the cost of a stamp by just dropping the envelope in the secure drop box in front of the Clubhouse.

NOTE - All member contributions received, regardless of the receipt date, are for the calendar year in which they are received.

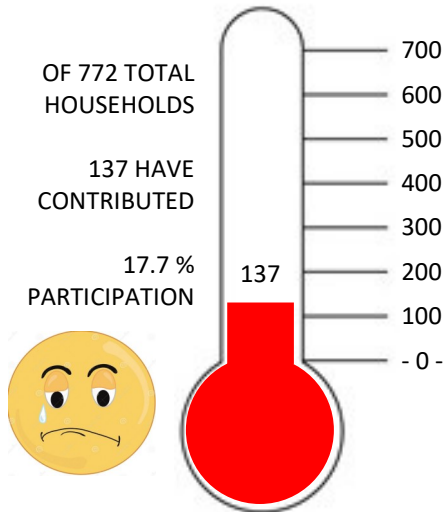

**ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION STATUS**



In the January Newsletter, we kicked off our annual contribution drive. We detailed how your contributions fund the various community activities and children’s holiday parties. We asked that you check with your friends that live in HOA communities and see what they pay annually in mandatory HOA dues and what they receive in return. We also have a safe, simple method to make a contribution online through our website or even on your phone if you have either the Venmo or Zelle app if a mailed check is too inconvenient.

As of May 15<sup>th</sup>, only 137 of our 772 households in Florida Gardens have recognized the need for their involvement and have been generous enough to contribute. **THIS IS LESS THAN LAST YEAR AT THIS POINT IN TIME.** Most have contributed \$50 or more. Some have contributed less. To everyone who has contributed thus far, we say THANK YOU!

In this Newsletter, we have again included simple instructions on how to use our website to make your contribution online, and a contribution coupon for those of you who like to contribute by check. All contributions received, regardless of the receipt date, are for the calendar year in which they are received. The Association fiscal year runs from Jan 1<sup>st</sup> to Dec 31<sup>st</sup>.

Please consider what this great community has to offer and make a contribution to help keep our activities funded.

REMINDER : We have several ways to contribute. You can make your annual contribution to the Florida Gardens Civic Association by check. You can use any credit card online from our website (floridagardens.net). Simply select “CONTRIBUTE” from the main menu and follow the directions. Finally, you can also pay using Venmo or Zelle. If using Venmo, enter @Floridagardensca as payee. If prompted, use 0541 as the last 4 digits of the payee phone.

# DOG OWNERS : DO THE RIGHT THING

Animal owners in Florida Gardens should be aware of the following statement from the Palm Beach County Animal Care and Control Ordinance 98-22:


**Section 4-9 Animal Waste**

*The owner of every dog and cat shall be responsible for the removal of any feces deposited by his/her animal on public property, public walks, public beaches, recreation areas, or private property of others.*

If a violation of this ordinance is observed, it can and should be reported to Palm Beach Animal Control at (561) 233-1200 Ext. 0. It is important to note and report the address of the offender(s) so appropriate action can be taken.

Fines for this civil infraction are as follows:

Section 9 - Animal waste	
1st Offense	\$50.00
2nd Offense	\$100.00
3rd offense and all subsequent offenses	\$250.00
Plus \$ 16.00 court costs for all offenses	

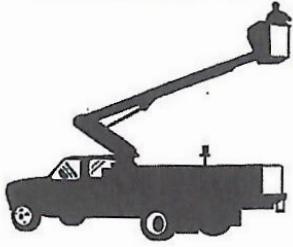


Pet Supermarket (Publix, also) sells a variety of bags for removal of your pet's waste. It is the right thing to do - and it is the law.

Seven years ago, an uproar was created when the then editor of this Newsletter published a front page article (shown here) about residents failing to pick up their dog poop. It encouraged residents to identify offenders and report them to the County for fines. While this problem still continues to this day, the Board of Directors would prefer that residents who walk their dogs simply 'do the right thing', pick up their dog's waste and take it home for proper disposal (NOT putting it in someone else's trash can). It is not the responsibility of the Board of Directors to enforce proper behavior of our residents. Anyone seeing an offender must decide for themselves what action they want to pursue to try and correct the behavior of that offender. All the Board can do is continue to ask residents to be responsible dog owners and 'do the right thing'.
