**Colonel Robert Newbern**, a longtime and active member of the Florida Gardens community, passed away on Veterans Day, November 11, 2020, at the age of 99. A Florida native, he was born in Sebring on July 26, 1921. He had resided on Plumosa Lane, adjoining "Newbern Park," since June, 1974, following his retirement after a long and distinguished career as an officer in the U.S. Air Force. At the time of his passing he was the oldest known resident of Florida Gardens, and, as a member of the "Greatest Generation," the last known veteran of World War 2 still living in Florida Gardens. We noted the Colonel's



99th birthday in the September issue of the Florida Gardens Newsletter, and we were looking forward to celebrating his 100th, which unfortunately didn't come to pass.

Colonel Newbern is survived by his wife Florence, his children and numerous other relatives, and his many friends, both in Florida Gardens and elsewhere. We recognize and thank him for his long service to his country, and needless to say, he will be missed.

#### **Another Bit of Florida Gardens History**

In my article in the May 2020 Newsletter on Florida Gardens History, I made mention of Karl Beachler's efforts to have a Turnpike Interchange constructed at Lake Worth Road to support his vision of his planned Florida Gardens Village. He successfully lobbied the Governor and the Turnpike Authority to build the interchange to what was at that time called the Sunshine State Parkway, and according to Angela Starke, who is the Communications Director in the Florida Turnpike Communications Office, a formal ribbon cutting ceremony for the interchange was held on October 15th, 1960. The photo below was taken at the ceremony. Some of the dignitaries that are in the photo are as follows:

The two gentlemen in the dark suits at the center are, on the left, Thomas B. Manuel ("The Father of the Turnpike" as the first Chairman of the Turnpike Authority), and on the right, then Governor LeRoy Collins. The tall gentleman shown left of Mr. Manuel is Charles B. Costar, an influential businessman who persuaded Florida officials in 1953 to authorize construction of the Turnpike. Karl Beachler is to the right and in back of Governor Collins. We have also been told that John Pennekamp is present in the photo, but we don't know which one he is. Also, another individual in the photo is then Florida Senator George Smathers. Beyond that, we do not know the names of anyone else in the photo.


