Lucerne Lakes Golf Course Conversion Update

On October 28th, the Palm Beach County Commission approved the conversion of the Lucerne Lakes Golf Course by a 4-2 vote. However, based on a number of questions from the Commissioners directed to the County Attorney as a result of documents provided by the residents and their attorney, it is likely that the next step will be a court battle.

Florida Gardens History:

Can you guess the location of this Florida Gardens Photo?

If you guessed the community entrance at Ohio Road, you would be <u>wrong</u>. Those of us who have lived in this community for quite a number of years know that Karl Beachler (the developer of Florida Gardens) and his wife Mary lived in the home on Ohio Road just north of the church. But most do not know that it wasn't their first house in Florida Gardens (actually not even their second). Karl and Mary first lived in a house that was built right at the <u>Akron</u>



entrance just about where the Gold Mine sits today. This photo of their house was taken from Lake Worth Road at the Akron Road entrance in 1953 as the community was first being laid out. The turnpike construction had not even been approved yet, let alone started. When Lake Worth Road was widened to 4 lanes in the late 1970's and the area was developing rapidly, the residential properties along it became highly desirable for commercial use. The corner property in the photo where the Beachler house stood (they had long since moved to another house) was sold to Exxon Corporation in 1986. The house was demolished and a gas station was constructed there. Over the years, that gas station was sold to Chevron, then converted to a travel center and finally to the Gold Mine business there today.


