At our Annual Christmas Party, we are offering a new way to give back this year by giving someone a lifesaving Christmas present.



<u>Sabrina's Story</u> - [Continued from Page 3] - Sabrina Mesa is the daughter of longtime residents of West Cypress. In July Sabrina was diagnosed with Severe Aplastic Anemia (SAA). Here is her story.

Severe Aplastic Anemia is a rare but serious blood disorder. It happens when your bone marrow can't make enough blood cells and platelets. My SAA started with just a couple of small bruises. Within a week I was waking up with new bruises every day, as well as pin-like red spots known as Petechiae or Anemia Rash. I started to feel kind of tired as well, but I was very active spending a lot of time exercising and just chalked it up to that. It wasn't until my gums started bleeding profusely for multiple days just from brushing my teeth that I knew there was something wrong. It was a Friday when I went to get blood work just to see what was going on, and almost exactly 24 hours later I was receiving a phone call from my doctor to tell me my blood levels were severely low. It took multiple tests and bone marrow biopsies to confirm that I had a very extreme case of SAA. I've received 35+ transfusions between platelets and whole blood and have spent approximately 30 days in the hospital so far. I've received my first round of ATG (Antithymocyte globulin) and am currently looking for a BMT (Bone Marrow Transplant) donor match.

**INFORMATION ON THE SILENT AUCTION :** As you know from the article in the September Newsletter, Member Contributions this past year were roughly the same as last year, as was income from Clubhouse rentals. However, the cost of hosting our Kids Parties continues to increase. To raise funds to support continuation of these parties, there will be a Silent Auction at the Christmas Party. **NOTE TO BUSINESSES :** We are looking for businesses or anyone who would like to donate a gift or gift card that we can use for the auction. A business donation can include a copy of your business information (business card, etc.) to promote your business. All auction proceeds will benefit our various kids parties. #### **ONGOING NEED FOR STREET REPS**

**The Street Reps are the voice of the residents.** Their input helps shape the function, activities and direction of the Community. Without their representation, the residents have no voice. But as critical as the position of Street Rep is, it takes very little time or effort. You don't even have to be a resident of the street you represent (although that is always the preference). The 'duties' of a Street Rep are simple and outlined in the By-Laws. First, since you represent the residents, attend the monthly Residents Meeting. There are only 10 per year (we don't meet in July or August) and last about an hour or less. There can even be two people acting as a Street Rep for a street - a Primary and a Secondary so if one can't make it the other can take their place. Second, the Street Rep is responsible for insuring that the community Newsletter, published 5 times per year, gets delivered to all the houses on their street. This doesn't mean you have to do it yourself. If necessary, you can find someone to do it for you. Your responsibility is simply that it gets done. That's about it. So why, with an average of about 44 houses per street, is it so difficult to find a few people willing and able to support this community by filling the pending Street Rep vacancies? If this simple but vital activity is something you would be willing to volunteer for, please contact Mike Misko. Get involved in your Community.


