

LUCERNE LAKES GOLF COURSE ELIMINATION UPDATE



As those of you who monitor our community happenings on Nextdoor, or who read the March and June minutes of our monthly Association Meetings on our Florida Gardens website are aware, a developer has purchased the Lucerne Lakes Golf Course property (Forest Oaks) with the intention of eliminating it and replacing it with residential housing. The site plan posted in the Forest Oaks Clubhouse has been updated since its original publication. The new plan now calls for a total of 600 new units, consisting of 192 single family homes, 168 townhomes and 240 condo units. Of the total, 15 will be designated as workforce housing. As of this writing, according to the County, the revised application is still early in the Certification process and about a month before the first Zoning Board hearing, all residents within a certain radius of the project will be mailed a notice.

Our Association 1st Vice President, Susan Jenkins, is our liaison working with the Lucerne Lakes HOA to

coordinate the opposition to this development proposal. The developer's plan does not call for any additional access to the development other than the current main entrance and the access road (Columbia) which connects our development to theirs. This will no doubt increase the traffic entering at Ohio and also increase the number who short-cut to the turnpike by going along Springdale. Additional information on the progress of this proposed development will be posted on Nextdoor and our Facebook page as it becomes available.





We would like to congratulate Colonel Bob Newbern, an active and long time resident of Florida Gardens, who reached an important milestone when he celebrated his 99th birthday on July 26th. Bob, a native of Sebring, retired from the U.S. Air Force after a long career, and moved to Florida Gardens in 1974. He and his wife Florence live on Plumosa Lane, where they maintain "Newbern Park" adjacent to their home and remain active in community affairs. As far as we know, Colonel Newbern, a member of the "Greatest Generation," might be the only veteran of World War 2 still living in the Gardens, so we want to say "Thanks" for your long service and Happy Birthday from all your neighbors and friends.
