LUCERNE LAKES GOLF COURSE CONVERSION APPROVED BY JUDGE

Almost two years of litigation concluded on August 8th when Judge G. Joseph Curley of the 15th Circuit approved Mattamy Homes' petition to dismiss the lawsuit filed by homeowners in Lucerne Lakes which attempted to prevent the conversion of the golf course to a mix of 450 houses and townhomes. The judge's 27-page ruling addressed each of the positions put forth by both Mattamy and Lucerne Lakes and in each case sided with Mattamy. The judge also allowed Mattamy to sue the Lucerne Lakes HOA and the 3 residents who filed the suit to pursue recovery of Mattamy's lawyer fees if they so choose.

Assuming Mattamy elects to now proceed with their project, there will be several direct impacts to Florida Gardens. First, the construction of a left turn lane from Ohio Road onto Columbia Drive (as mandated by the County) will impact the properties of several residents at the north end of Ohio. Second, Mattamy verbally agreed to fund the installation of 2 speed bumps along Springdale Road to try and dissuade Lucerne Lakes residents from using it to bypass traffic on Lake Worth Road. Now that the project has been allowed to proceed, we will need to get back in touch with Mattamy and remind them of their commitment.


Florida Gardens Residents Only, Please


IMPORTANT NOTICE - From Ed Hinkle, President of the Lucerne Lakes HOA

A SPECIAL MESSAGE FROM SANDRA DALE - OUR NEW FGCA SCHOLARSHIP COORDINATOR

This year's scholarships are named for Edward A. Ridolph. Ed moved to Florida Gardens in June of 1974, and was a longtime member of the Florida Gardens Civic Association. Over the years, he held many positions in the Association; however he was known for overseeing the management of the Scholarship Awards from 1984 until his passing in 2021.

Ed was a loyal and decent man, to whom many looked to for advice. He was passionate about many things, including trolley cars, travel, photography, and especially, education. This enduring passion for education led to many generations of residents earning a scholarship under his guidance, which supported them in their pursuit of higher education.

He always ensured the young adults who earned this scholarship did so by contributing their time to the neighborhood. This scholarship has been one way the community recognizes the hard work and achievements of many of our outstanding students, and it also gives these deserving students a financial boost as they begin their college/trade careers. Over the years some of our recipients have gone on to become teachers, lawyers, architects, medical workers, as well as enjoying success in a variety of fields.

ONGOING NEED FOR STREET REPS

Every resident in Florida Gardens is a member of the Florida Gardens Civic Association, Inc. The Association is governed by a representative Board of Directors, which consists of five elected Officers, three appointed Directors at Large, and 19 Street Representatives. The Street Reps are the voice of the residents. Their input helps shape the function, activities and direction of the Community. Without their representation, the residents have no voice. But as critical as the position of Street Rep is, it takes very little time or effort. You don't even have to be a resident of the street you represent (although that is always the preference). The 'duties' of a Street Rep are simple and outlined in the By-Laws. First, since you represent the residents, attend the monthly Residents Meeting. There are only 10 per year (we don't meet in July or August) and last about an hour or less. There can even be two people acting as a Street Rep for a street - a Primary and a Secondary so if one can't make it the other can take their place. Second, the Street Rep is responsible for insuring that the community Newsletter, published 5 times per year, gets delivered to all the houses on their street. This doesn't mean you have to do it yourself (but it is a good way to connect with the people you represent). If necessary, you can find someone to do it for you. Your responsibility is simply that it gets done. That's about it. So why, with an average of about 44 houses per street, is it so difficult to find a few people willing and able to support this community by filling the pending Street Rep vacancies? 
