During his deployment there, he earned the Combat Action Badge, Army Commendation Medal, and Army Achievement Medal for his distinguished duty and service in Operation Enduring Freedom.

Joel is also a dedicated public servant. Now a wealth management advisor, he served as the Mayor of the City of Greenacres from 2017 to 2024. As the 8th largest city in Palm Beach County, Greenacres is known for its amazing amenities and safety, making it a great place to live. As Mayor, Joel focused on serving and protecting his community, volunteering in the community, and mentoring youth. He also served on several boards, including the Transportation Planning Agency of Palm Beach County, Palm Beach County League of Cities, and Lake Worth West Residential Planning Agency.

REMINDER: SAFETY WALKING AT NIGHT

FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY - PLEASE! Some reasonable suggestions for anyone out walking at night: 1) Wear light, bright clothing - NOT BLACK - and better yet one of those reflective safety vests. 2) Walk <u>facing oncoming traffic</u>. If there are no sidewalks, Florida law 316.130(4) specifies that pedestrians must walk on the shoulder of the road AGAINST the flow of traffic. 3) Carry a flashlight. 4) When you have a vehicle approaching, get well off the road until the vehicle passes. This applies to your dog as well. 5) Be very careful around the numerous package delivery vehicles making night deliveries. Please make an extra effort to stay safe walking at night.




