Senior parents are also expected to participate in putting together the Senior Picture Frames and helping plan Senior Day on the last home game of the regular season. ***

Transportation and Conditioning Clearance Cards

Green cards **MUST** be stamped at the trainers before being turned into the office with check for **\$90** before athletes are cleared to play or allowed to travel on bus. Player turns in one copy to the office and the other copy goes to coaching staff. The \$90 goes toward bus fees so please try to utilize the bus by having your player ride for both directions. Detailed instructions on the clearance process can be found on the cover page of the clearance packet athletes already received from coaches.

If you plan on taking your player home from an away game she has taken the bus to, it is **MANDATORY** that you turn in a filled out copy of the **Driving Permission Form** to Coaches returning on the bus, **NO EXCEPTIONS**. A copy of the Driving Permission form can be found in this packet.

****Adults are not cleared to transport kids other than their own without clearance from the district and written consent from the legal guardian of the athlete.****

Registration Due Tonight:

Varsity, JV, and Frosh \$365 Program Donation

Check payable to EHS Field Hockey.

Registration covers coaches' payment, insurance, socks, compression shorts, uniform/equipment purchases and maintenance, yearbook/banquet book, awards, and general program costs.

Varsity, JV, and Frosh: \$150 Uniform Deposit

(This will not be cashed unless items are lost or damaged).

\$450 Goalkeeper Uniform Deposit (This will not be cashed unless items are lost or damaged beyond normal wear and tear sustained during play; this is a **separate** deposit from the uniform deposit detailed above).

What your player will be given:

- **Kilt** must be kept at a length of at least 13" long. **DO NOT SHORTEN OR YOUR DEPOSIT WILL BE LOST!!!** Buttons can be moved to adjust waist. Hand wash cold, delicate. Hang dry to retain pleats. **DO NOT PUT IN DRYER!** Turned back in at end of season.
- **Jerseys** can be washed per the instructions on inside tag. NO BLEACH. Please be cautious of using spray sunscreen as we have had issues with discoloration on polos before. Turned back in at end of season.
- **Team Duffle Bag.** Turned back in at end of season.
- **Socks and compression shorts for under kilt.** Green and white uniform socks are for players to keep. It is a MANDATORY REQUIREMENT that players wear the "modesty" shorts under their kilts during games or when worn to school. Players must wear the black undershorts given to them with their uniforms or ones that look identical to them as they are a part of their uniform. Compression shorts are for players to keep along with their socks.

***Other mandatory equipment for games and practices includes** shin guards, mouth guards, and goggles. Mouth guards must be one solid color (clear and white are not allowed) with nothing protruding from them and shin guards must cover from ankle to below the knee.*

Secret Sister Gifts:

Secret sister gifts are a fun package of healthy snacks for players to enjoy on AWAY GAMES ONLY. **Please limit costs to \$5.** Keep secret sister wish list for whole season to use as a general guide. A larger gift with a \$20 price limit will be given at the end of the season banquet when secret sister identity is revealed. **If you are not attending a game, it is your responsibility to make sure your gift gets to your secret sister. If you are unable to leave gift with someone else, please contact Varsity Coach Becca as soon as you know you will not be able to do so.**

Important Dates to Remember/Schedule Information:

Practices will be held every day of the school week

- **Varsity** – from 1:30 to 4:00pm (**arrive at 1:15**)
- **JV** – from 3:00 to 5:00pm (**arrive at 2:45**)
- **Frosh** – from 3:00 to 5:00pm (**arrive at 2:45**)
- **Players are expected to show up at designated arrival times** for set up/warm up so that they are getting in at least a full 2 hours of practice time. Varsity is responsible for equipment set up for both practices/games. JV and frosh will be responsible for cleanup and putting equipment back. Practices will take place on both the turf and back grass corner behind the baseball diamond.

Season game schedules for all teams will be posted at edisonfieldhockey.com

- Any schedule changes will be communicated via email and updated online. Players are required to arrive an hour before game time to set up/warm up for home games. Meeting times for bus departure will be emailed out as they will vary. Varsity players are expected to stay for at least one half of the JV or Frosh game to show support unless otherwise cleared with coach.

- **Picture Day – All 3 teams, September 26th.** Players will wear white uniform polos, kilts, green sweaters, and closed toed tennis shoes. Exact time TBA.
- **Senior Day is Friday October 26th**, the last home game of the regular season. We commemorate this day with something special for girls graduating from the program with a pregame ceremony and snacks outside of the turf.
- **Pasta Party Team Dinners: Wed. 9/19, Wed. 10/10, and Wed. 10/24.** Each team will host 3 pasta party events during the course of the season to be held at the home of a parent volunteer with 4 assistant parent helpers to cater/supervise. Each team will have their parties as individual groups (as opposed to all 3 teams at once.)
- **Breast Cancer Awareness Month. Players for all 3 teams will wear pink socks** during home games for all of October to commemorate Breast Cancer Awareness month. These pink socks are included in their uniform kit and are theirs to keep.

Fundraising Events:

- **Opportunity Drawing:** Each player is responsible for selling 8 tickets. Turn in date for tickets/money is **Tuesday, 10/2**. Drawing will be held at turf on **Friday, 10/5** during set of home games.
- **Restaurant Fundraisers:** Dates TBA for **Chipotle** and **Mama's** restaurants.
- **Banquet Book Ads:** Families can place congratulatory ads for their players in the end of the Season Banquet. Details to be distributed shortly.
- **End of the Season Banquet –** Seacliff Country Club, December date TBA.

EHS Functions Rule:

It is school policy that there will be NO ALCOHOL at any Edison functions whether they be on campus or not. This includes but is not limited to games, pasta parties, and banquets. More information on proper parent/guardian conduct can be found in your Parent Communication pamphlet.

Team Communication: Mass emails will be our primary form of communication. If you have not been receiving emails thus far or if you change contact information mid-season, please email **Suzanne Schriber** at edisonfieldhockey@gmail.com so that your correct info is added to the contact list. It is very important that players and parents be checking their email regularly throughout the season for last minute updates and reminders. We will also be posting important information, stats, and results at edisonfieldhockey.com in addition to our twitter feed @EdisonFldHockey.

Players MUST COMMUNICATE with their respective coaches via text or email if they are missing any part of a practice or game day! Emergencies and commitment conflicts are expected to crop up, but it is very important that players value/attend practice time as we are limited in what we can go over if the team does not show up as a whole. Detailed information on communication guidelines for coaches and the Edison athletics department can be found in your Parent/Coaches Communications Guide.

Commitment to the Team/Expectations of Players:

Field hockey is an athletics class and a grade is assigned based on attendance and conduct. Players are expected to show teammates, coaches, officials, parents, fans, and opponents respect at all times. Athletes are expected to represent the field hockey program with honor by meeting their academic requirements and conducting themselves properly while on campus and off. Equal expectation of assistance in field/equipment maintenance and set up/clean-up is placed upon players of all ages, grades, and team levels.


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
