Parent Volunteer Needs

<u>Team Parent Representatives (1 per team)</u>

***All parents are encouraged to volunteer in some capacity to keep the program running. If you are unable to volunteer yourself, please think of friends/relatives to fill in hours to contribute for your daughter. Sign up via SignUp Genius link. Senior parents are also expected to participate in putting together the Senior Picture Frames and helping plan Senior Day on the last home game of the regular season.

EHS Functions Rule: It is school policy that there will be NO ALCOHOL at any Edison functions whether they be on campus or not. This includes but is not limited to games, team events, and banquets. Registration for Varsity, JV, and Frosh

\$350 Season Donation Check payable to Edison Field Hockey.

Registration covers coaches, league dues, umpires, insurance, socks, uniform/equipment purchases and maintenance, Banquet Book, awards, and general program costs.

\$150 Uniform Deposit Check payable to Edison Field Hockey.

This will not be cashed unless items are lost or damaged.

\$450 Goalkeeper Equipment Kit Deposit

This will not be cashed unless items are lost or damaged beyond normal wear and tear sustained during play; this is a *separate* deposit from the uniform deposit detailed above.

*** Transportation and Conditioning Clearance Cards Green cards MUST be stamped at the trainers before being turned into the office with check before athletes are cleared to play or allowed to travel on bus. Player turns in one copy to the office and the other copy goes to coaching staff. These funds are utilized for bus fees so please try to utilize the bus by having your player ride for both directions. Detailed instructions on the clearance process can be found on the cover page of the clearance packet athletes already received from coaches. If you plan on taking your player home from an away game she has taken the bus to, it is MANDATORY that you turn in a filled out copy of the Driving Permission Form to Coaches returning on the bus, NO EXCEPTIONS. A copy of the Driving Permission form can be found in this packet and on the website.

What your player will be given

Kilt must be kept at a length of at least 13" long. **DO NOT SHORTEN OR YOUR DEPOSIT WILL BE LOST!!!** Buttons can be moved to adjust waist. Hand wash cold, delicate. Hang dry to retain pleats. **DO NOT PUT IN DRYER!** Turned back in at end of season.

Jerseys can be washed per the instructions on inside tag. NO BLEACH. Please be cautious of using spray sunscreen as we have had issues with discoloration on polos before. Turned back in at end of season.

Team Backpack. Turned back in at end of season.

Socks. Green and white uniform socks are for players to keep.

Other mandatory equipment for games and practices includes shin guards, mouth guards, and black compression shorts to be worn under kilt. Mouth guards must be one solid color (clear and white are not allowed) with nothing protruding from them and shin guards must cover from ankle to below the knee.

Program Expectations / Practice Schedule

Practices will be held every day of the school week Varsity – from 1:30 to 4:00pm (arrive at 1:15)

JV – from 3:00 to 5:00pm (arrive at 2:45)

Frosh – from 3:00 to 5:00pm (arrive at 2:45)

Players are expected to show up at designated arrival times for set up/warm up so that they are getting in at least a full 2 hours of practice time. Varsity is responsible for equipment set up for both practices/games. JV and frosh will be responsible for cleanup and putting equipment back. Season game schedules for all teams will be posted at edisonfieldhockey.com

Any schedule changes will be communicated via email and updated online.

Players are required to arrive at least an hour before game time to set up/warm up for home games. Meeting times for bus departure will be emailed out as they will vary. Varsity players are expected to stay for at least one half of the JV or Frosh game to show support unless otherwise cleared with coach.

Players MUST COMMUNICATE with their respective coaches via text or email if they are missing any part of a practice or game day! Emergencies and commitment conflicts are expected to come up, but it is very important that players value/attend practice time as we are limited in what we can go over if the team does not show up as a whole. Covid Guidelines for Athletics: While we could not be more thrilled to finally be entering organized league play since Fall 2019, the coronavirus pandemic remains a serious concern that all players must continue to be mindful of to lower risk of transmission and insure participation in a full, healthy season. As a program we are required to adhere to all covid-related guidelines and safety precautions determined by local and state public health authorities and the HBUHSD.

Any players experiencing any covid related symptoms including but not limited to fever, cough, sore throat, congestion/runny nose, loss of taste or smell, headache or gastrointestinal distress, MUST STAY HOME from field hockey and communicate symptoms directly to coaches immediately. Players are required to inform coaches if they have had recent exposure to a potential/confirmed covid positive person or have recently tested positive themselves, even if asymptomatic. Players experiencing any of the situations/conditions above CAN NOT return to practice before the clearance return date determined by Edison nurses/training staff in charge of contact tracing. Per these policies, any unvaccinated athletes exposed to covid will have a mandatory isolation period of at least 10 days before being allowed to return to field hockey, even with proof of a negative test.

It is important that players continue to be vigilant and responsible in adhering to the guidelines and practicing cautious behavior as we return to athletic competition and in person education. It is our highest priority to protect the health and safety of our athletes and their families while minimizing the potential for mandatory isolation times for individual players and their teams. Mask Requirements for Busses: Players are required to remain masked at all times while traveling on busses to and from games this season in accordance with school and district policy. We will be seeking exceptions for players eating/drinking for the rare games where we will have to travel during lunchtime due to commutes exceeding an hour. This exception can only be decided by our assigned bus driver as we must be in compliance with covid safety policies. Players must have their windows down to increase ventilation while eating, can *NOT* share any food/drink, and will be required to immediately mask up after finishing eating/drinking. It is entirely up to the bus driver assigned to our bus that day to allow for this exception, so we must prepare for this option to be denied while players remain masked at all times during bus travel. Players will always be prohibited from eating/removing their masks on the bus when traveling to opponents local to our area.

Commitment to the Team/Expectations of Players: Field hockey is an athletics class and a grade is assigned based on attendance and conduct. Players are expected to show teammates, coaches, officials, parents, fans, and opponents respect at all times. Athletes are expected to represent the field hockey program with honor by meeting their academic requirements and conducting themselves properly while on campus and off. Equal expectation of assistance in field/equipment maintenance and set up/clean-up is placed upon players of all ages, grades, and team levels.
