The following responses were provided by youth who have been taught Heritage Keepers in Fall 2022. Most of the youth came from buss'd up family situations & we taught them in a secular setting. Others were churched youth on Oahu & Molokai. The **bold** subheadings are categories of repeated themes and emphases in the youth responses. Most responses/emphases could have been placed within multiple categories.

# "I am a person of value"

- I would recommend this program so that others know how much of a value they are and for them to not count themselves out. It made me realize that in order to give myself to someone and not feel bad about it, I have to learn, know, trust the person, and get married so I feel good about it. I liked that this program showed me that I have a lot of power that I did not know I had.
- This program helps us understand the reality of sex and why it's much better to have sex within lifelong, loving marriage so that it helps with a better love life. Abstinence helps us women respect our bodies. I liked everything about it. It made me think twice about my sex life & also gave me the target for sex that I want (marriage). # "Reinforced abstinence for lifelong, loving marriage"
