

AFFIDAVIT OF CRIMINAL CONSPIRACY

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746: I, _____, being of lawful age and competent to testify, declare under penalty of perjury that the following is true and correct based on my personal knowledge and records in my possession.

I identify Judge _____ of _____ County, _____, as a party acting under color of law. In addition, there are other officers, agents, or employees of the state who acted in concert with the named judge and who bear responsibility for the violations set forth herein.

I declare that violations of the Constitution of the United States and applicable federal statutes have occurred. The constitutional provisions implicated include Article VI (Supremacy Clause), the 4th Amendment (protection against unreasonable searches and seizures), the 5th Amendment (guarantee of due process), the 7th Amendment (right to trial by jury in civil matters exceeding twenty dollars), and the 14th Amendment (equal protection and due process guarantees). The statutory provisions implicated include 18 U.S.C. §§ 242 and 241 (criminal deprivation of rights and conspiracy to deprive of rights).

On or about _____, my minor children were unlawfully removed from my custody without lawful warrant, jury determination, or proper due process of law.

Judge _____, acting under color of law, issued and/or enforced orders that deprived me of my parental rights and custody of my children. These actions were taken without a finding of unfitness supported by evidence beyond a reasonable doubt, without providing the proper jury trial guaranteed under the 7th Amendment, and without any findings of abuse or neglect to my children. Said actions caused irreparable harm to me and my children, including but not limited to loss of companionship, emotional distress, and deprivation of familial association protected under the U.S. Constitution. The removal of children under these circumstances constitutes an unlawful seizure, denial of due process, fraud upon the court, oath of office violations, perjury, deprivation of rights, and other violations ascertainable by other evidence in the record.
