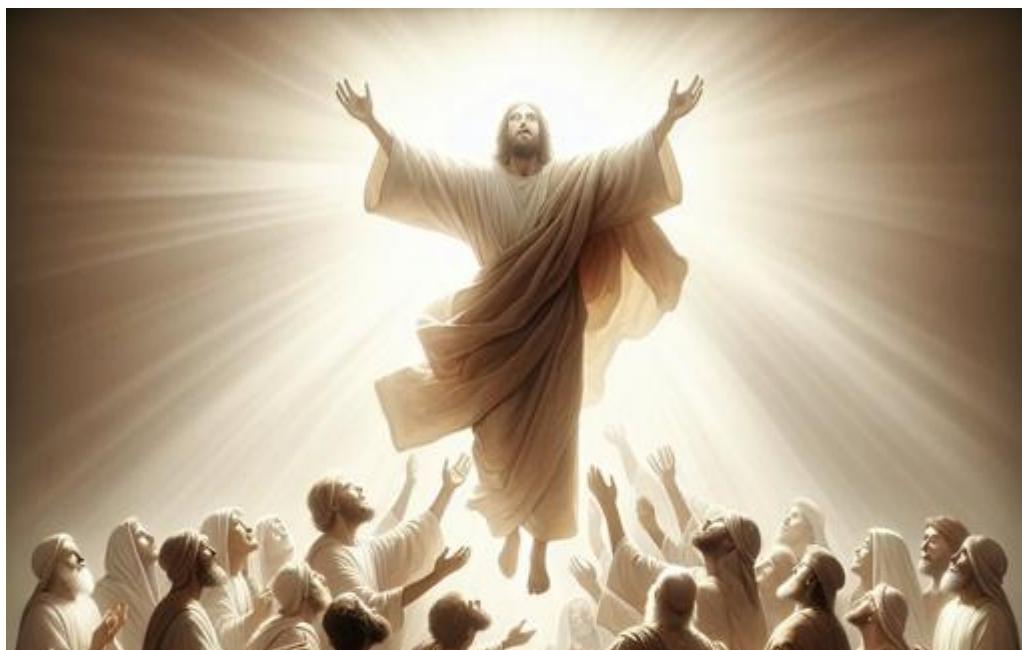

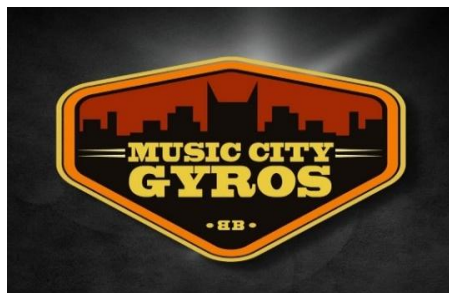


Online Giving
