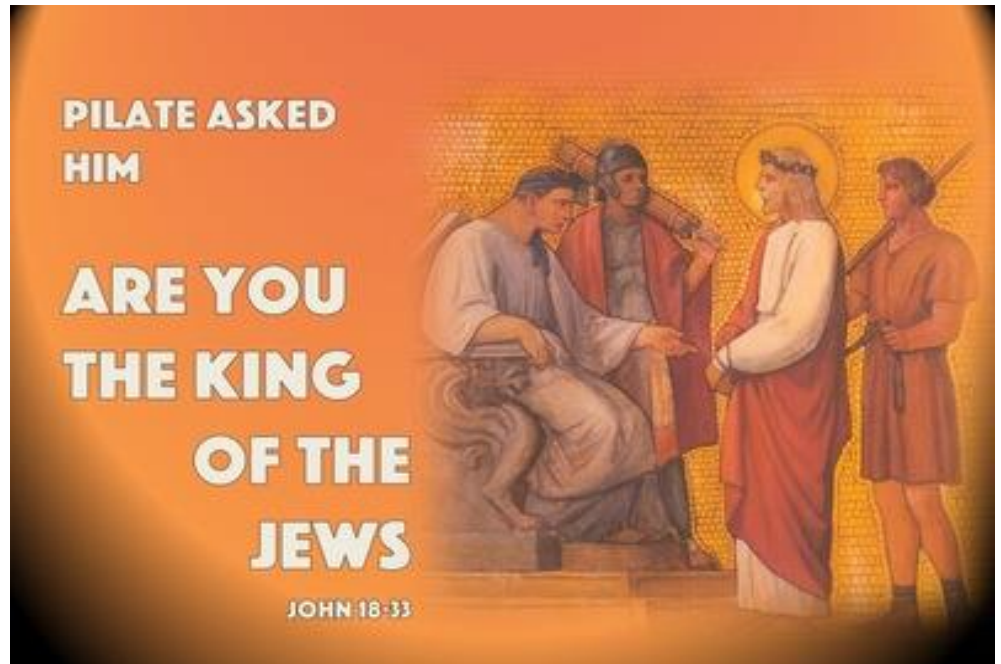

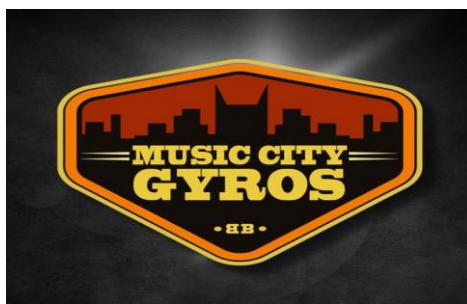
Cathedral Choir Christmas Concert
