About Us

The Lowcountry Foundation for Wounded Military Heroes (LFWMH) is a tax-exempt 501(c)(3) organization based in Bluffton S.C. and dedicated to providing support to combat wounded military heroes in the Lowcountry of South Carolina and Georgia. The Foundation funds qualified charities that provide needed services to our combat-wounded military veterans and their families. We are not affiliated with the Wounded Warrior Project.

Our Mission

Our mission is to support wounded military heroes through charitable programs reviewed, approved, and recommended by Birdies for the Brave, a PGA Tour Charities affiliate. These programs are designed specifically for the individual needs of our Wounded Heroes as they assimilate back into the civilian population. For every dollar donated to the Foundation, we spend essentially 100% in direct support of program activities.

Our History

For the past 14 years, our Lowcountry Foundation has been raising funds to support our local wounded veterans who have served in the Iraq and Afghanistan wars. Our funding comes through a variety of local events including primarily our Annual Wounded Heroes Golf Classic that honors over 80 heroes each year — Purple Heart recipients and combat injured/medically retired servicemen and servicewomen. Our 14th Golf Classic will be held on May 19th 2025 at Hampton Hall and Oldfield Golf Clubs and Wexford Golf Club on May 5th. In our short history we have donated \$2,289,000 to organizations that provide direct services to our Wounded Heroes.

Our Team

We are a 100% all volunteer organization comprised of individuals with varied backgrounds and excellent work and military experience. The full team consists of 240 volunteers that conduct various fund raising events. We pay no salaries. In addition to Hampton Hall, Wexford and Oldfield, other communities that participate in our fund raising events include: Crescent Pointe (Annual Veteran's Week Golf Event) Belfair, Berkeley Hall, Riverton Pointe Golf Clubs and Hampton Lake.
