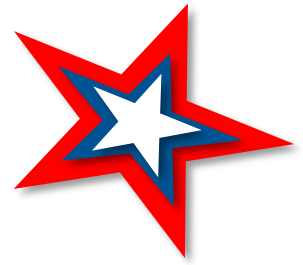
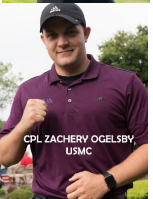

About Us

The Lowcountry Foundation for Wounded Military Heroes (LFWMH) is a tax-exempt 501(c)(3) organization based in Bluffton and dedicated to providing support to combat wounded military heroes in the Lowcountry of South Carolina and Georgia. The Foundation funds qualified charities that provide needed services to our combat-wounded military veterans and their families. We are not affiliated with the Wounded Warrior Project.

Our Mission

Our mission is to support wounded military heroes through charitable programs reviewed, approved, and recommended by the Birdies for the Brave, a PGA Tour Charities affiliate founded by the PGA player Phil Mickelson and his wife Amy. These programs are designed specifically for the individual needs of our Wounded Heroes as they assimilate back into the civilian population. For every dollar donated to the Foundation, we spend essentially 100% in direct support of program activities.

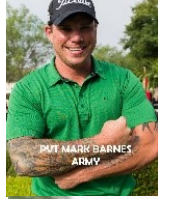
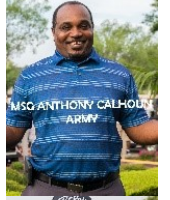
Our History

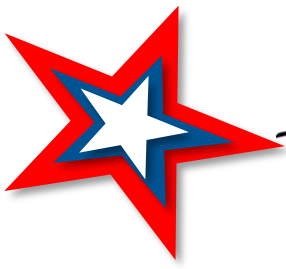
For the past 10 years, our Lowcountry Foundation has been raising funds to support our local wounded veterans who have served in the Iraq and Afghanistan wars. Our funding comes through a variety of local events including primarily our Annual Wounded Heroes Golf Classic that honors over 50 heroes — Purple Heart recipients and combat injured/medically retired servicemen and servicewomen. Our 10th Golf Classic will be held on May 18th, 2020 at Hampton Hall and Belfair Golf Clubs. In our short history, we have donated over \$1,235,000 to seven organizations that provide direct services to our Wounded Heroes.

Our Team

We are a 100% all volunteer organization comprised of individuals with varied backgrounds and excellent work and military experience. The full team consists of 240 volunteers (and growing) that conduct various fund raising events. We pay no salaries. In addition to Hampton Hall and Belfair, other communities that participate in our fund raising events include: Berkeley Hall, Wexford, Hampton Pointe, Hampton Lake and soon to be others.
