
Allen Brooks Is Tragically Twisted, Releasing New 4K Music Video! "Rebel rock meets post-apocalyptic speed and freedom"

Even though Brooks writes and records all of his own music in an analog environment, in 2025 he has started stepping into the future, weaving in Al-assisted imagery that gives the piece a surreal, dream-like sheen—where analog soul meets digital distortion.

Behind the spectacle lies authenticity. Brooks' backstory—a seasoned touring musician, military veteran, and NYFA-trained filmmaker—infuses every frame with weight and conviction. He's not posing for the camera; he's channeling decades of grit, grind, and gratitude. Maples matches that energy note for note, grounding the chaos with six-string electricity.

At just over four minutes, *Tragically Twisted* feels like a defiant shout from the edge of the world. It's a celebration of freedom, survival, and the enduring power of rock in an age of algorithms. Fierce, stylish, and unflinchingly alive, Allen Brooks and Keith Maples remind us that rebellion still has a soundtrack—and it sounds gloriously twisted.
