Allen Brooks is a professional musician, filmmaker, and New York Film Academy graduate (2010) based in Grandview, Missouri. His creative work blends traditional musicianship with modern visual storytelling, driven by a philosophy of authentic human creativity.

The Sound of Experience

Allen's journey began with a passion for music that led him from the U.S. Navy (1980-1984) to stages across the country. He has performed in countless bands, including Roxx Gang, Mojo Gurus, and Bishop Steel, sharing the stage with legends like Steppenwolf, Lou Gramm (Foreigner), and Molly Hatchet. After a battle with tendinitis in 2004, Allen shifted focus to composition and filmmaking, though his 'burning drive' for music remains as strong as ever.

The Lens

Under the creative identity B.A. Brooks, Allen has become a visionary in digital filmmaking. He was a pioneer in using online media to construct feature films, including 'The Decline And Fall Of America' (2008). His work includes a music video for Warner Bros. and a series of award-winning, AI-enhanced visual projects that have gained international festival recognition.

The Mission

Beyond the arts, Allen is a dedicated humanitarian who earned a diploma in Veterinary Assisting (2015) and helped save over 1,000 dogs in rural Missouri (2015-2019). Today, he champions the 'Human Music Initiative,' advocating for transparency and AI labeling in the arts. While Allen utilizes AI as another visual tool for cinematography, his music remains human-made, with 'Jackalope Jack' being his only limited experiment with this new technology.

- 'Comin' Home' (2026): Allen's 'KC Style' mixing classic rock and blues genres.
- 'Wars Waged By Man' (2026): Allen releases his new 'Kansas City Style'.
- 'Changes' (2025): Allen's heartfelt tribute to Ozzy Osbourne.
- 'Heroes': A new rendition of the Bowie classic (currently in development).
