LEVELS DEFINED

- a) Identity and maturity begin at birth, born/born again/child
- b) Adolescence: development in wisdom/understanding and character GAL 4:1–2
- c) Young man: anointed with power for ministry to do the will of the father and carries delegated authority.
- d) Father: pro-creator and birther, completing the task and mission: death, burial and resurrection for multiplication, receives all authority
 - e) Lord: conqueror, victorious, rulership and crowned

JESUS PATH TO MATURITY

- f) Born: named Jesus, LK2:21, not Christ or Lord
- g) Adolescence: LK2:51-52 grows under parental authority.
- h) Young man: matures into the name Christ: the anointed one; Tested to prove anointing; operates in delegated authority from the Fathers to do His will LK 3:21–22, 4:1-2,14,17-18,21.

Anointed with the Spirit of the Lord, and sent. His identity fulfilled as the Christ to do the will of the father.

- i) Father: procreates and reproduces, operates in all authority. JN 20:21–22; MAT 28:18–20
- j) Lord; the name acquired on completion/victory PHIL 2:5–11. vs9 "therefore:" Jesus name is Lord; crowned: REV 19: 12–16, name is Lord of lords.

- m) Young man/ "Christ-ian": anointed ACT1:8 Pentecost for a purpose/sent; MK16:17–18, 1JN 2:13–14, strong, victory in testing's, overcome the evil one because the word of God lives in him n) Father: 1JN2:13-14, Knows the Father/Love; births Christ in others GAL4:19; makes disciples MATT 28:19–20; rulership and authority
- o) Lord/crowned: REV 19:16 Lord of <u>lords</u>: Five crowns: Joy 1THES 2:19; Righteousness 2TIM4:8, Life JAM 1:12, Glory 1PET5:4, Imperishable 1COR9:25.
