Event Details

Event Timings	Entries close on Wednesday 30th September 2026 at 5.00pm. Registration from 9.15am Please follow the signs to the registration area from the carpark. Practice bosses will be open from 9.15am. Assembly at 10.00am. Shooting will commence at 10.30am on the whistle.
Entry Fee	One day fee: £15 for seniors / £8 for juniors and archers with a disability Two day fee: £25 for seniors / £13 for juniors and archers with a disability Family fee, where there are 3+members of a family shooting: One day £25 / Two days £40. The entry form will be available on the Lough Cuan Bowmen website and Facebook pages.
Event Format	➤ This is a 2 day shoot ➤ Target groups will consist of 3-4 archers ➤ The course is 24 targets per day ➤ Targets and pegs will be adjusted for day 2 ➤ Shooting pegs will be Red, Blue, Yellow and White
Eligibility	All competitors must be members of Archery GB or a World Archery affiliated organisation. Membership cards or e cards must be shown at registration
Awards	Medals will be awarded to highest placed archers shooting both days from the appropriate peg for their age group and bow classification. Medals will be awarded in all categories according to the number of entries: ➤ 1-3 entries – Gold ➤ 4-5 entries = Silver ➤ 6 or more entries – Bronze

Classifications

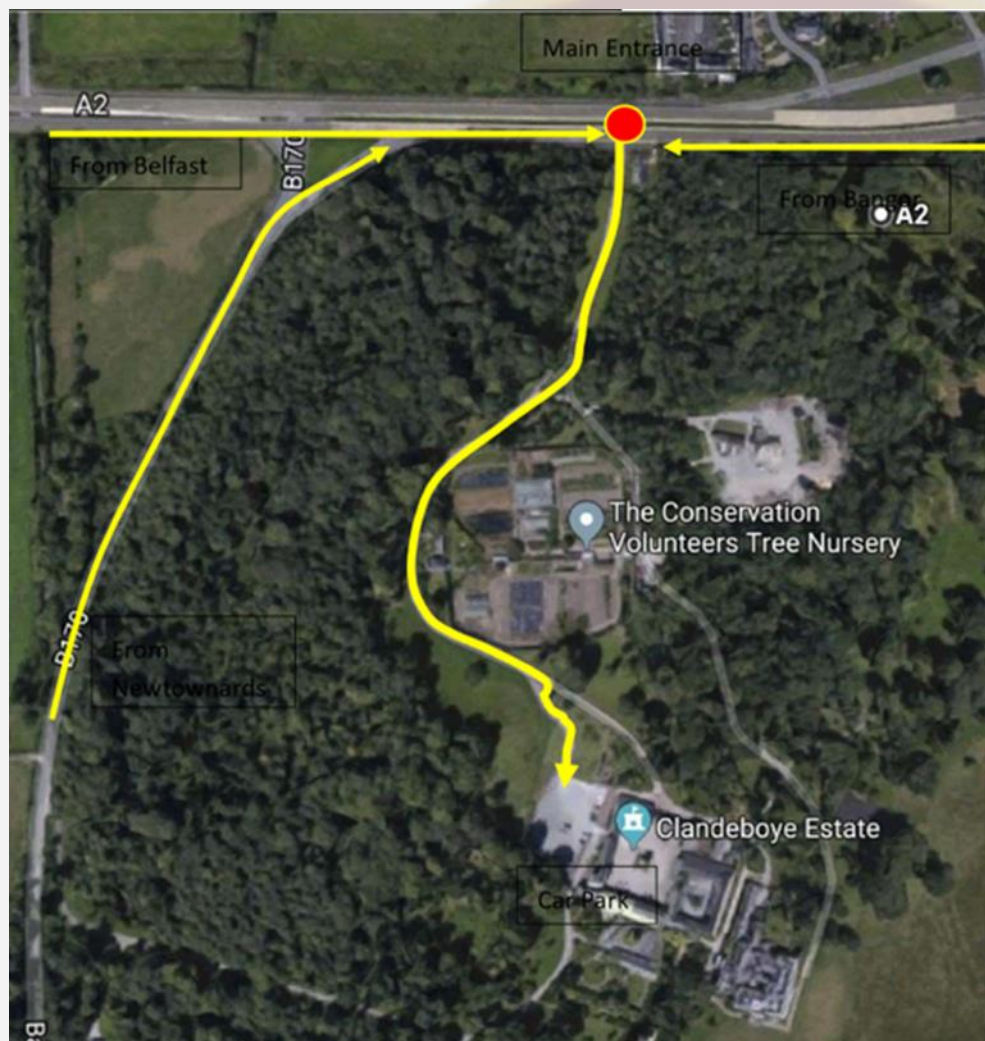
Archer Classification	Classifications for the shoot are: ➤ Senior – Open and Women ➤ 50+ - Open and Women ➤ Open – U21, U18, U16, U15, U12 ➤ Women – U21, U18, U16, U15, U12
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Procedures

Junior Shooting Groups	Juniors will be placed in the same group as their senior family member if shooting. If a senior family member is not shooting then the junior members must be accompanied by a parent / adult family member / responsible designated adult and will always remain the responsibility of their parent/guardian.
Special Requirements	Archers with a disability, other special requirements or have a matter they wish to raise, should contact the Tournament Organiser at Secretary@loughcuanbowmen.org
Red Call	If emergency assistance is required in the field the following procedure will apply: ➤ The archers call the target number followed by RED. ➤ When the call is heard by other archers they will immediately stop shooting and repeat the call. ➤ Shooting will recommence on a whistle. ➤ No-one will resume shooting until the restart is signalled.
Lost Arrows	When searching for lost arrows, please ensure that one archer always remains in front of the boss. If a shooting group arrives at the target, please move on and do not delay the shooting. Please record all lost arrows on your scorecard then transcribe them to the lost arrow sheet at the end of the shoot.
Smoking	No smoking, including e-cigarettes and VAPE cigarettes is permitted on the course.

GDPR	In submitting your entry to the competition, the following information will be collected and shared with Tournament Organisers, scoring systems and other competitors to aid the administration of the shoot. For example, target lists and results will be published: First name, Surname, Bow Style, Shooting Classification, email, Club (and ID), University (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability information. Information collected will be held to assist ANI/Club records
Photography	Photography is permitted on the course however, we request that in line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event register at registration on arrival. Please ensure if taking photographs you do not distract archers shooting. Please note in line with the Photographing & Filming Children & Young People in Sport policy you may be required to obtain written permission from the subject and/or their parents/carers to publish images on the internet or in print. Photographs may be taken by LCB (designated marshal) and may be used for the club website, social media, club newsletter and in publicity articles (e.g., AGB magazine). If parents/carers/children have any particular concern about their child/young person being photographed or filmed, please bring this to the attention of the registration team.
Allergies	Please inform the Tournament Officer at Secretary@loughcuanbowmen.org prior to the competition if you have any allergies which may affect you or other archers
Car Parking	Ample carparking will be available free on the site.
