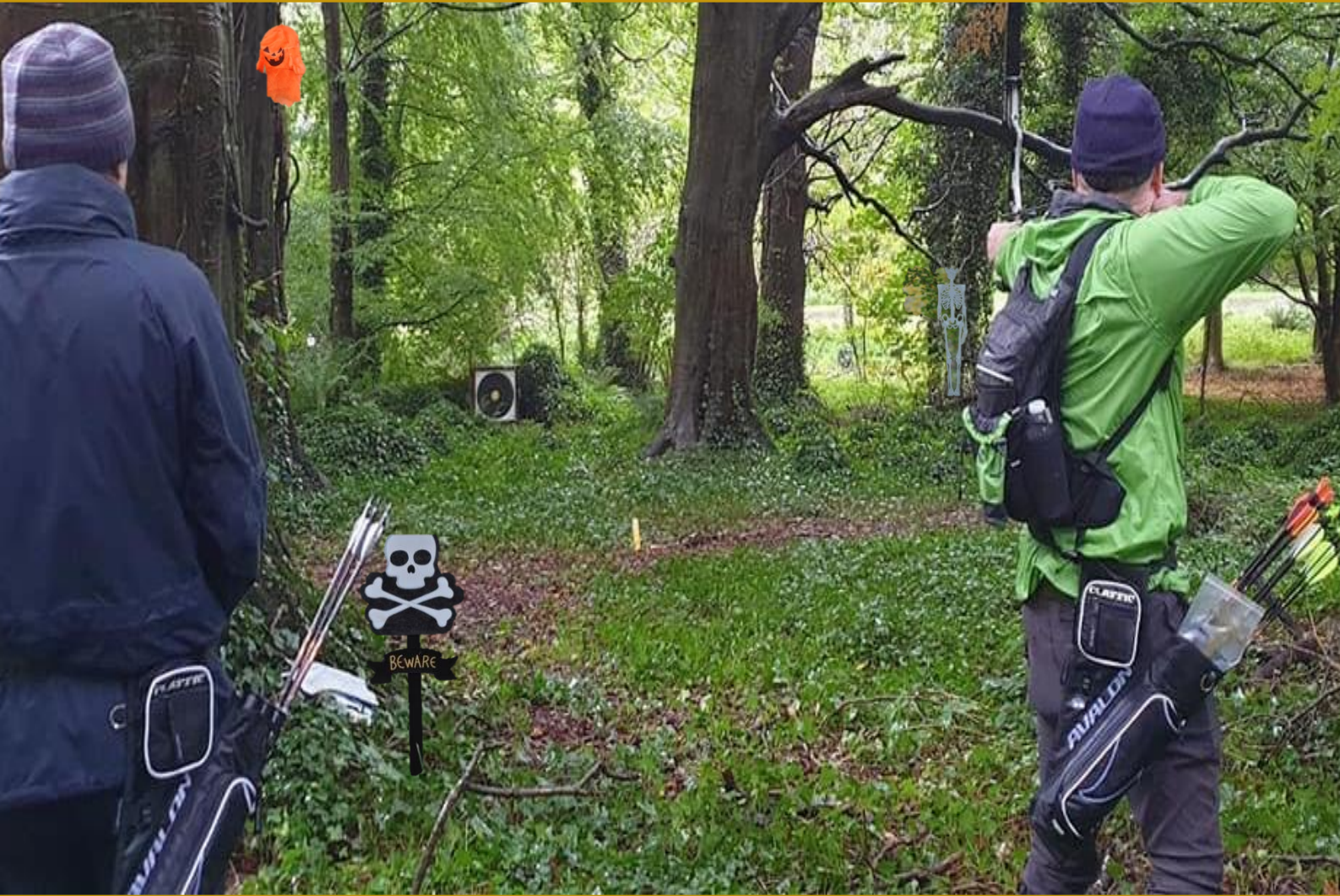

<b>Event Timings</b>	<p><b>Registration:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Socially distanced registration and assembly <b>for all archers.</b></li> <li>• Registration for all archers will be from 9.30 am, with assembly at 10.00am and shooting commencing at 10.30am</li> <li>• When you arrive, please complete registration and collect your scorecard and join your target group.</li> <li>• Your <b>Target Group number</b> will be displayed adjacent to registration on the grass verge.</li> <li>• Please observe social distancing conventions while waiting. As a club we recommend a minimum of 1 metre social distancing and the wearing of a face covering if within closer proximity.</li> <li>• Target groups will be led unto the course by a marshal.</li> </ul> <p><b>End of Shoot:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When you finish shooting, please return to the car park . Please <b>do not walk back</b> on the course as other archers may be still shooting.</li> <li>• Please leave the venue when you have packed your equipment away. (sorry,it does sound harsh)</li> </ul>
<b>Entry Fee</b>	<p><b>£10 for Seniors and £5 for Juniors (Exact fee would be appreciated)</b></p> <p>Entries to be submitted via google forms. <b>Event Format</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Target groups will consist of 3/4 archers</li> <li>• The course will be 24 targets</li> <li>• 3 arrows to be shot for field targets</li> <li>• Shooting pegs will be, Red, Blue, Yellow and White</li> </ul>																																																																																																				
<b>COVID</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Please respect social distancing requirements within your target group and with other competitors and officials.</li> <li>• Each boss will have sanitiser and wipes and a bag for the disposal of wipes. We would encourage you to sanitise your hands after each end of shooting.</li> <li>• We also recommend a ‘quiver pack’ with your own personal PPE should you wish to take additional precautions, face covering, tissues, rubber gloves etc.</li> </ul>																																																																																																				
<b>Archer Classification</b>	<p>Classifications for the shoot are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Senior:– Men and Women</li> <li>• Master:– Men and Women</li> <li>• Junior Men:– Under 18, Under 15, Under 12</li> <li>• Junior Women:– Under 18, Under 15, Under 12</li> </ul>																																																																																																				
<b>Awards</b>	<p>Medals will be awarded to highest placed archers shooting from the appropriate peg for their age group and bow classification. Medals will be awarded in all categories according to the number of entries.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 – 3 entries = 1 medal.</li> <li>• 4 – 6 entries = 2 medals.</li> <li>• 7 or more entries = 3 medals.</li> </ul>

<b>Junior Shooting Groups</b>	<p>Junior archers will be placed in the same shooting group as their senior family member if shooting. All juniors must be supervised by a responsible adult (Parent/Guardian/Carer/Adult family member)</p>																																																																																																				



## Lough Cuan Bowmen

<b>Red Call</b>	If emergency assistance is required in the field. <b>The following procedure will apply.</b> The archers call the target number followed by <b>RED</b> . When the call is heard by other archers, they will immediately stop shooting and repeat the call. Shooting will recommence on a whistle. No one will shoot until the restart is signalled.
<b>Dress</b>	It is recommended that competitors wear clothing appropriate to the venue and weather conditions.
<b>Lost Arrows</b>	When searching for lost arrows, please ensure that 1 archer remains in front of the boss at all times. If a shooting group arrives at the target, <b>please do not delay shooting.</b> Please <b>record all lost arrows on your scorecard</b> and we will make a note of them.
<b>Allergies</b>	Please inform the Tournament Officer prior to the competition, <a href="mailto:tournamentofficer@loughcuanbowmen.org">tournamentofficer@loughcuanbowmen.org</a> if you have any allergies which may affect you or other archers in the course of the competition
<b>Smoking</b>	No smoking (including e-cigarettes and VAPE cigarettes) is permitted on the course.

## For Your Information

<b>GDPR</b>	In submitting your entry to the competition, the following information will be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors to aid the administration of the shoot for example, target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Bow style, Shooting classification, Email, Club (and ID), University (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
<b>Photography</b>	Photography is permitted. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child/young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the organisers. Please note in line with the Photographing & Filming Children & Young People in Sport policy you may be required to obtain written permission from the subject and/or their parents/carers to publish images on the internet or in print. Official photographs may be taken on the day and these may be used for LCB publicity purposes, including web site and social media sites.
<b>Car Parking</b>	Parking will be available free on site, adjacent to the registration area. We would request under current COVID-19 conditions that you park 2 metres apart where possible. (2 doors width).

## Halloween Club Shoot 2021

We have been able to make some changes because of an easing of the COVID regulations over the summer. However, we are still conscious of the spread of the virus and therefore we will still be maintaining several of our procedures regarding HANDS – FACE – SPACE.

### First things first? Should I attend?

Please do not attend if:

You have any Covid-19 symptoms

You are required to self - isolate for reasons set out in government guidelines or regulations



### Thinking Ahead

- You will be sent details of your shooting group via email.
- We recommend a quiver pack with hand sanitiser and additional PPE you feel you may need.



### Arrival

- Please keep to the right-hand side of the car park
- Where possible please allow 2 metres between cars. (2 door width)
- This will allow you space to set up your equipment.



### Registration

- Go to the registration point.
- Observe the 2 metre ground markers.
- Please have your entry fee ready (exact fee please) and place it in the cash box.
- Collect **individual scorecards**.
- Join your target group, at designated marker and observing social distance
- A marshal will then take your target group to your starting target.



### Shooting

- Archers will shoot as normal, respecting social distancing rules
- Archers will pull their own arrows, using foot or knee against the target for leverage
- Arrow holes should not be marked
- Line cutters must be decided by group.
- Should you need to wipe the target face wipes are provided at the rear of the boss.
- We recommend cleaning hands after each target. Sanitiser is provided, but feel free to use your own.



### Course

- Please maintain current social distance within your group
- Please maintain an appropriate distance between the group ahead and the group behind
- No "catching up" allowed
- A field marshal(s) member will be on the course to assist you if required.
- Please respect other archers in their desire to maintain social distancing



### Finishing

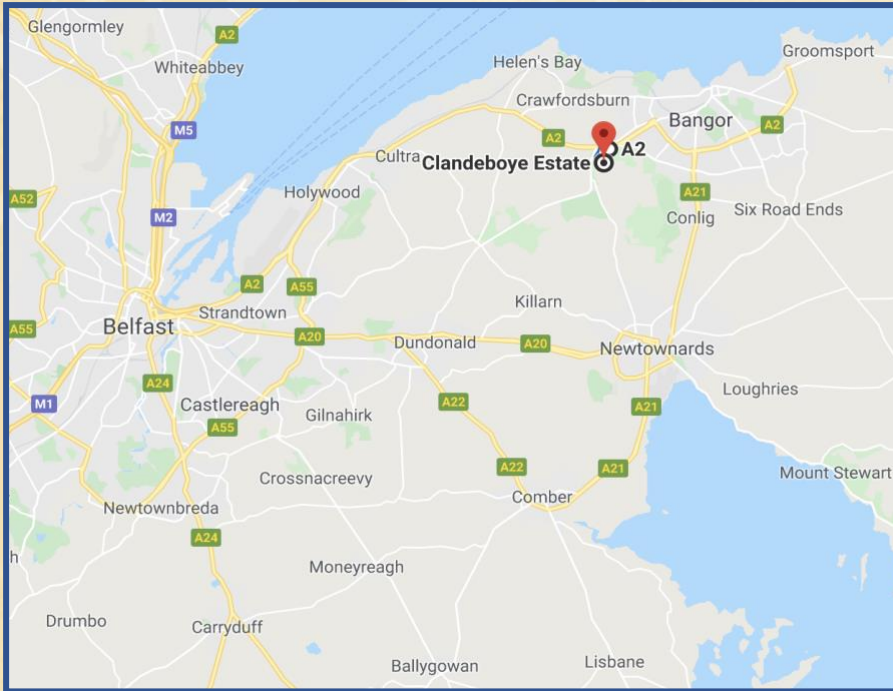
- When you finish shooting, please return to the car park.
- Return score card to box at registration table in carpark
- Archers must then pack up and leave the venue.

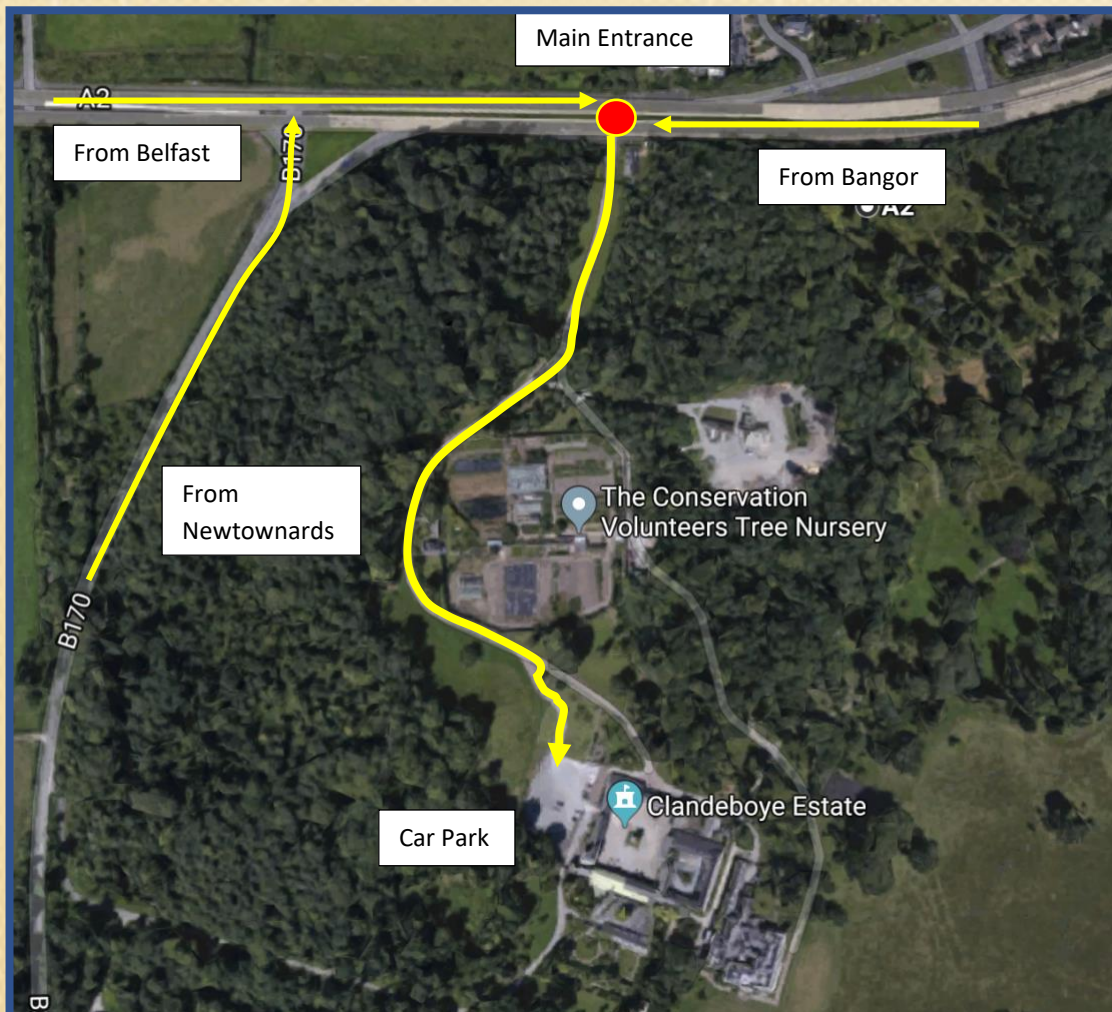
### Where exactly is Clandeboye Estate?

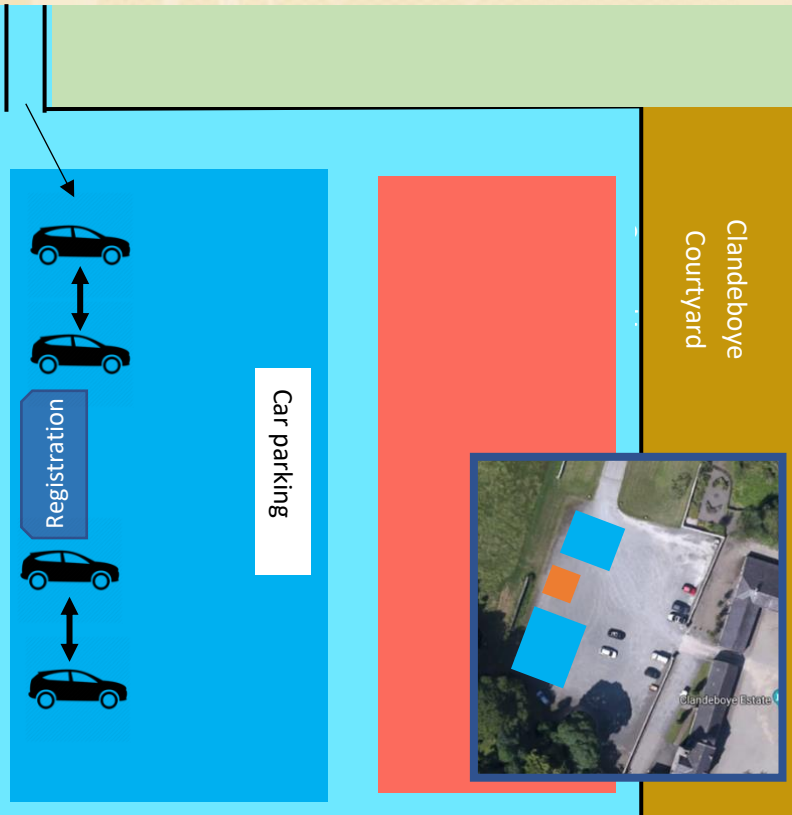

### Car parking at Clandeboye Estate

On entering the car park, please park on the right hand side of the carpark. If space allows , try to park 1 car width apart
