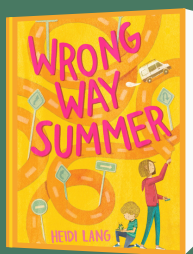

Wrong Way Summer

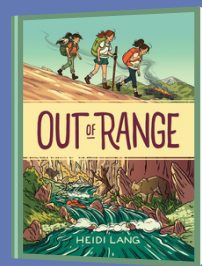

FOR IN-PERSON VISITS:

Once date is confirmed, Heidi will be in touch with any additional information (travel costs, flyer for parents, equipment needed, etc.).

FOR VIRTUAL VISITS:

Due to school security constraints, you will need to provide Heidi with the link to whichever virtual platform you prefer (Zoom, Skype, etc.).

TO PREPARE FOR VIRTUAL BOOK CLUB/CLASSROOM Q&AS:

- (1) Provide Heidi with a link to your preferred virtual platform
- (2) Have your students come up with a list of questions prior to Heidi's appearance, to be emailed to her 24 hours in advance

(3) Heidi will do her best to answer any day-of questions as well

NOTE: Questions can be about anything – the book, writing tips, author life, etc., but Heidi will not give away future book plot spoilers.
