### HOME IMPROVEMENTS & ARC APPROVAL

If you are planning any architectural improvements to your home, fence, or property, you must first check with the City of Fayetteville and submit a Modification Form to the Farrer Woods Board in care of the ARC Committee for review and approval.



Please allow up to **30 days** for a response before beginning work.



### WEED CONTROL REMINDER

Weeds are beginning to appear in yards, sidewalks, walkways, and driveways. Please take a few minutes to remove weeds and help keep our community looking its best.

This simple process costs little to nothing (unless hiring a company or purchasing weed-control products), and it really will help to improve the look of your home and our community.



### PET CLEANUP REMINDER

Georgia law states persons who permit their animals to defecate on public or private property other than their own property are required to immediately pick up the feces, bag the feces, and properly dispose of it.

Please pass this information to relatives, caregivers, and dogwalkers who may occasionally walk your dog. This is for everyone's safety.



### TRASH COLLECTION REMINDER

TRASH PICKUP DAY IS **WEDNESDAY**.

- Place your container out the night before your collection day.
- Keep garbage cans four feet apart.
- Place containers at least four feet or more from any obstacles such as mailboxes, cars, lamp posts, or power lines.

### PARKING REMINDER

**PLEASE, NO DOUBLE PARKING IN THE CUL-DE-SAC.**

If your parking causes obstruction to the emergency services, you could face being fined.

According to the Emergency Workers (Obstruction) Act 2006 it is an offence, without reasonable excuse, to obstruct or hinder certain emergency workers responding to emergency services.

### COMMUNITY REMINDERS



#### SPEED LIMIT

No speeding – the speed limit is 25 miles per hour unless otherwise posted. So slow down and follow all traffic signs to protect you and your neighbors.



#### YARD SALE PERMITS

The City of Fayetteville requires a permit for all yard sales. The permit number must be displayed on all signs posted or citations may be issued.

Watering for lawns is allowed only during the following hours:

**4 P.M. TO 10 A.M. ONLY**



### **WATERING BAN:**

No irrigation is permitted between 10 A.M. and 4 P.M.
