The city is full of many museums, European charm and historic architecture, along with many shops and boutiques. Day nine we visit Charlottetown, PEI, on the south shore of Prince Edward Island, known for its many beautiful natural settings and local mussels. Next we sail to Bar Harbor, Maine, located on Mount Desert Island which was once housed by the Rockefellers, Vanderbilts and Carnegies to name a few. One can visit the Acadia National Park which has a network of hiking trails and beautiful views of the Atlantic. Then we travel back to Boston, arriving early enough to perhaps visit the Old Corner Bookstore, Paul Revere's House, a museum of fine art, Samuel Adams Brewery and enjoy all types of fresh seafood.*
