**December 16, 1961-** The Breckenridge Ski Area officially opens with one Heron double chairlift and a short T-bar. Almost 17,000 skier visits were recorded that first season, despite the fact that Interstate 70 was still not complete to Summit County. Look how it has changed since that first ski season!

The 2011–12 ski season marked the ski resort's 50th anniversary season, with the resort implementing a year-long celebration in honor of a half-century since the resort was founded on December 16, 1961.

Breck has five huge peaks, 2,908 acres, four terrain parks, a 22 ft Superpipe, 11 bowls, the highest chairlift in North America, family-friendly terrain and a world-class ski school, all situated above an authentic, hip mountain town with awe-inspiring views. Trail and lift names on Peak 6 reflect a common theme of the resort's Peak 6 branding, "Awaken Your Sixth Sense".

Renowned for the welcoming spirit and friendly character of their locals, with over 200 restaurants, bars, and shops, and numerous year-round activities and events, there are many good reasons why "Breck" is one of the most popular ski resorts in the Western Hemisphere.

Fun Facts: Vertical – 3,398 ft, Top Elevation – 12,998 ft., Base Elevation – 9,600 ft., Runs – 14% - Beginner, 31% Intermediate, 19% Advanced, 36% Expert; Longest Run – Four O'Clock – 3.5 miles; Lift System – 32 Total (1 gondola, 4 high-speed six-packs, 6 high-speed quads, 1 fixed grip quad, 1 triple chairlift, 6 double chairlifts, and 13 surface). Snowfall is 370 inches per year.

There is plenty to do in Breckenridge after a day of skiing, you can enjoy the quaint little town for some shopping with over 200 shops or enjoy a night out with a stop at a local Brewery.
