However, this will be considered a "shared" or "bareboat charter", meaning EVERYONE is part of the crew. Everyone will have a chance to sail, cook, clean, and work together for a fun week.

Cruising in style.... All of these boats have 4 cabins and 4 private bathrooms. We will use one cabin on each boat for the Skipper and his/her guest which leaves 3 cabins on each boat for club members.

SCHEDULE:

Arrive on Sunday, May 24th and board the Mooring's catamaran at 5pm. We will spend the night on board the catamaran and we suggest dinner at Pusser's. We will set sail around noon on the 25th. You will have time to grocery shop for extra provisions Sunday evening or Monday morning.

GETTING TO/FROM Tortola:

Tortola

You can fly directly into Tortola (Beef Island) Airport from San Juan

St Thomas

You can fly to St. Thomas and take a 45 min ferry ride costing about \$105 round trip

CREW KITTY

There are a lot of "variable expenses" that are impossible to predict. The Skipper will ask everyone to pitch in for the "crew kitty" when they board. This "usually" amounts to about \$100-\$150/person for a week. The amount depends on what the crew spends and how frugal or not they are.

SOME of the things the "crew kitty" is used for:

Additional Boat Water (if the crew uses their water and needs to replenish)

Mooring Balls or Dock Space (varies based on the location)

Additional or upgraded provisions (you never know how much or little people may or may not drink)

Trash Disposal (it's free at the Moorings, but other places charge)

Ice (this is a biggie....we get two bags per day of free ice at the Moorings, but when we are away, you can plan purchasing several bags/day)

Anything else the crew wishes to purchase with their "Crew Kitty" (the Captains are
